Privacy Policy

The Privacy Policy shall set forth the key principles that apply to the privacy of information collected by us on adsider.com website.

Data and Personal Information Collection

We collect personal information such as e-mail directly when you fill out our online subscription form on our website. The information you provide may be used for marketing purposes and to inform you by email about the latest news, interviews and cases, our new products and products from our partners.
