You have the right at any time to stop Bitworks Design from contacting you for marketing purposes. If you no longer wish to be contacted for marketing purposes, please contact us.

What are your data protection rights?

Bitworks Design would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request Bitworks Design for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Bitworks Design correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Bitworks Design to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that Bitworks Design erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
