

Human trafficking victims are hiding in plain sight, forced into labor, domestic servitude or prostitution. All are forms of exploitation, and we have a duty to stop it. Watch for and report the signs:

- Fear, anxiety, submission or nervousness
- Lack of freedom of movement or being constantly monitored
- Having no access to identification, earnings or medical care
- Allowing others to speak for them or being instructed by someone else
- Visible signs of abuse, such as bruises or scars
- Limited or no social interaction
- Limited contact with family or friends

You may be a victim's only chance to escape. Have the courage to speak out against it. If you suspect human trafficking in our workplace, reach out to an appropriate internal resource.
