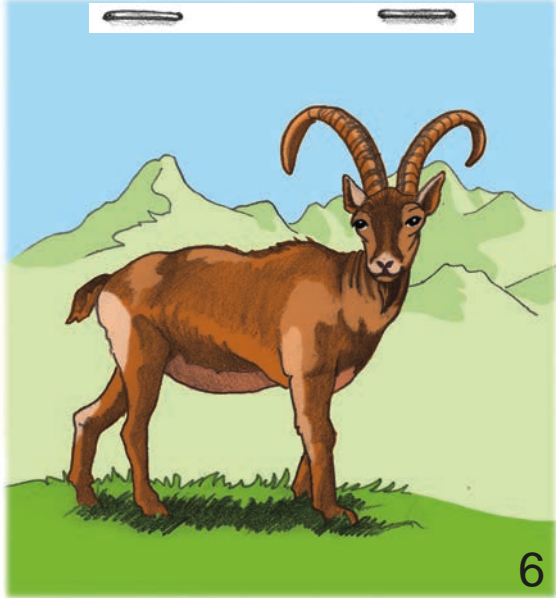
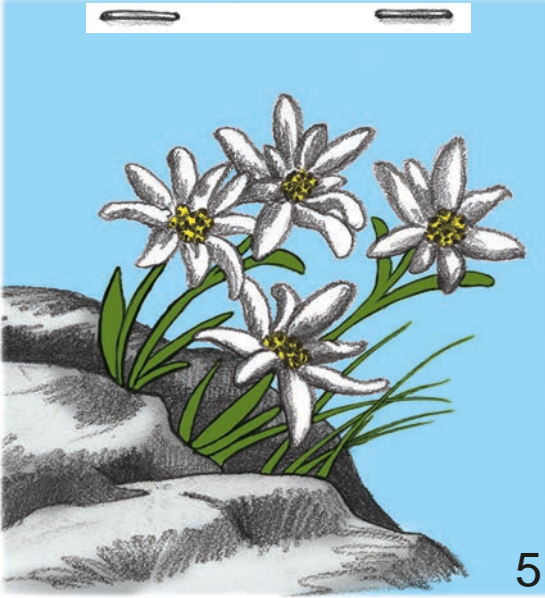
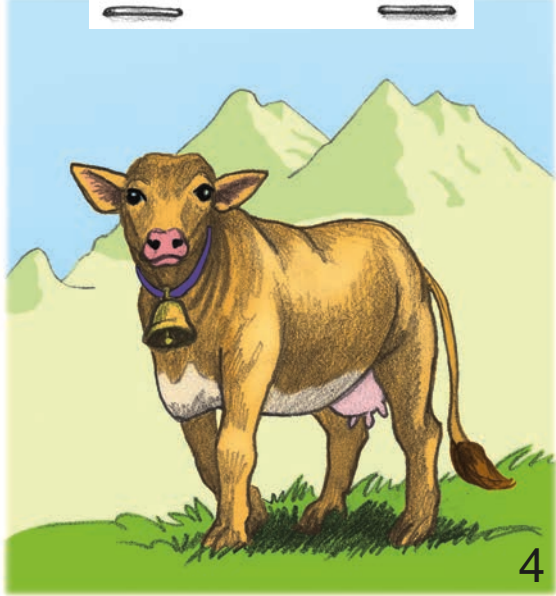
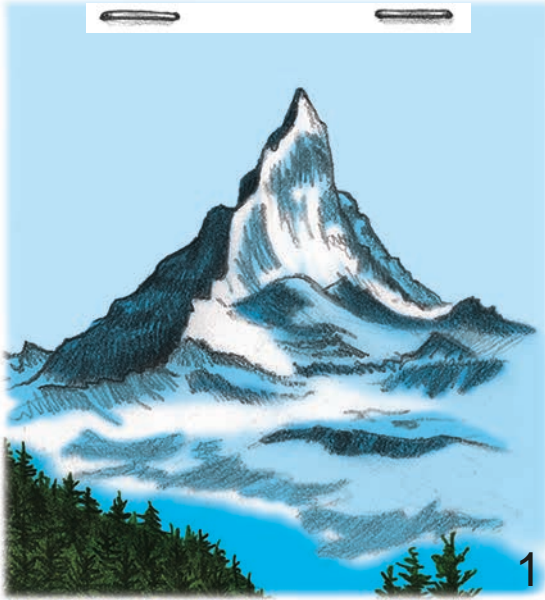
Instructions

1. Print pages 3-4 of this activity.
2. Cut out the cards on page 3. Place the cards on the table with the illustrations facing up.
3. “The Swiss Alps are a large mountain range in Europe that spans seven countries: France, Italy, Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Germany, Austria, and Slovenia. Here are some things that can be found in the Swiss Alps.”
4. One by one, read the following facts to your student.
 - Card #1:** One of the tallest peaks in the Alps—the Matterhorn—is nearly 15,000 feet high.
 - Card #2:** The alphorn is a long wooden horn that is used to communicate in the Alps.
 - Card #3:** The large Bernese mountain dog is known for its talent as a rescue dog in the Alps.
 - Card #4:** The Brown Swiss cow is native to the Alps and produces lots of milk.
 - Card #5:** Edelweiss is a white, star-like flower that is found in the Alps.
 - Card #6:** The ibex, a type of goat, lives in the mountains of the Swiss Alps.
5. Your student may then stack the cards, staple them into a small booklet, and paste the booklet to the sheet with the illustration of the Swiss Alps.
