Apple Learning Coach | Program Overview

Program Requirements

Apple Learning Coach is a free professional learning program for instructional coaches, digital learning specialists, and other educators in K–12, higher education, and nonprofit learning environments. Candidates' roles in their schools or districts must include instructional coaching of other K–12 educators. Program participation requires approval from school, district, or nonprofit organization leadership. For the best experience, we recommend completing the course within 4 months.

Application Requirements

To qualify for the Apple Learning Coach program, educators must have:

- Verification of Apple Teacher recognition
 - Apple Teacher recognition ensures that Apple Learning Coach candidates have already learned foundational skills on iPad or Mac; they'll take these skills further during the course.
- Capacity to coach
 - Applicants are required to describe their capacity to coach in the application. "Capacity to coach" means the applicant's role will allow them to coach at least one K–12 educator in a school or district. The program defines coaching as partnering with teachers to analyze their teaching, set goals, identify strategies to reach the goals, and provide support until the goals are met.
 - The program is designed specifically for educators who coach. So a condition of admission to the program is that applicants must be able to coach at least one K–12 educator once they've completed the course. The course content assumes that all Apple Learning Coaches work in a school or district.
- · Approval from school, district, or organization leadership
- All applicants need written approval from their school, district, or organization leadership to participate in the program.
- To begin the ethics approval process, applicants will be asked to provide their leadership's contact information.

Course Expectations

To complete this course, candidates must:


- Read all sections in every unit
- Earn 100 percent on all quizzes in each unit
- Submit a completed journal for each unit
- · Attend and actively participate in 2 days of virtual workshop sessions
- Submit a completed Coaching Portfolio at the end of Unit 6

Candidates will learn more about these expectations if accepted into the program.

Program Benefits

Apple Learning Coach candidates may be eligible to receive continuing education units (CEUs) from Lamar University recognizing that they've completed the training and materials. Once candidates have completed the course, they'll receive an email with instructions on how to request CEU credits from the university.

Depending on district and state policies, candidates may be eligible for credit to meet professional development hour requirements and to advance potential pay scale. School and district leaders can consider qualifying the Apple Learning Coach program for at least 43.5 hours of professional development.

Course Overview

Apple Learning Coach candidates who are accepted into the program will engage in an online course that consists of self-paced units and 2 days of virtual workshops with Apple Professional Learning Specialists. The experience provides participants with a network of fellow coaching educators, as well as Coaching Journals and actionable takeaways. It culminates in a Coaching Portfolio, which participants submit as their final assessment at the end of the program.

After completing the course, Apple Learning Coaches will be invited to engage in ongoing learning and networking with fellow coaches across the country.

Some app features require iPadOS 16.2 or later. Drawing activities are designed for iPad Pro or iPad (6th generation or later) and Apple Pencil. All apps are free and available on the App Store or included with iPadOS. Frequently Asked Questions

How much does the program cost?

There's no fee to participate.

Does the program have prerequisites?

Applicants must earn their Apple Teacher recognition in the Apple Education Community to gain foundational skills with Apple technology before they're accepted into the program.

Applicants also need to submit an application and get written approval from their school, district, or organization leadership.

What's the time commitment?

The estimated time commitment for completing the certification course is 43.5 hours, including a 1-hour virtual Kickoff and 2 days of virtual workshops.

What will participants gain?

Apple Learning Coach provides participants with a full course, actionable guides and templates, and a cohort of peers. Apple Learning Coaches may also be eligible to earn more than 40 hours of continuing education units.

Certified coaches will get exclusive access to virtual meetups, which provide a platform for reconnecting with peers and delving deeper into the knowledge and skills acquired during the course. These gatherings offer a valuable opportunity to exchange insights and refine coaching techniques. Certified coaches will also retain access to the course content as well as a dedicated space in the Apple Education Community to support and enhance their skills.
