2. Generate a pre-provisioning token: Customer IT Admin generates and sends a pre-provisioning token and Google Admin Domain ID to HP.
3. Pre-provision devices: HP performs pre-provisioning and registration with Google.
4. Enrollment completes: End user powers on the new device; identity is confirmed; device is auto-enrolled; policies applied; user logs in and gets to work.
