- Switzerland congratulates the Bureau for their excellent work drafting the zero draft of the New Urban Agenda. We consider the zero draft to a large extend a solid, comprehensive and integrated document - and certainly a very positive starting point into the discussion of the weeks and months to come.
- We would like to take this opportunity to make very few comments with regard to the zero draft's structure:
 - We very much appreciate the alignement and link with the 2030 Agenda throughout the entire structure of the zero draft, and in particular the understanding that the NUA shall operationalizes the 2030 Agenda.
 - However, in our view more emphasis should be put on making the document even more action oriented - including by more specifically referring to relevant SDGs and targets.
 - With regard the dimensions of sustainable development, is that in our view the environmental integration is overall rather poorly articulated in the NUA zero draft.
 - Further, we do see potential to get rid of some duplications within the document as well as to be more coherent between the sections, throughout the structure. For example, major commitments in part A are to be addressed by the effective implementation measures in part B.
- Several **important subjects to sustainable urban development** are already well reflected in the zero draft, such as e.g. the transversal themes 'urban migration' or the 'gender dimension' whereas we also see potential to strengthen or specify several elements thereof.
- Switzerland is looking forward to comment the text in a more specific way in the course of the week, when discussions arrive at the respective sections of the zero draft.
