I am excited to share with you this year's Annual Report highlighting Safe Harbor's work over the past 12 months. I remain humbled to work alongside such an amazing team of professionals and our Board of Directors, who make our work possible. Our team is passionately dedicated to fulfilling the mission of Safe Harbor every single day. They are bringing hope and healing to children and families of the 4th Judicial District. Through the support of generous donors, corporate sponsors, and state and federal funding we were able to provide 5,490 services to our clients in FY21. And while this is an increase from last year, we continue to maintain a waiting list for therapy services. My desire is to find a way to serve to every child in need of our specialized therapy services.

This year we are being more intentional about sharing our story in the form of memorial stones. Memorial stones have been used for thousands of years as a way to signify a turning point, a place or time of remembrance. Ancient Israel set up memorial stones as reminders of significant experiences and encounters as they journeyed through the wilderness to the Promised Land. We want to hold our clients' stories in the same kind of manner – as a reminder of turning points in their lives.

From the first time a child enters our center, our focus is on creating a safe, comfortable space for them to use their voice to share their experience. As they journey through their time at Safe Harbor, they continue to use their voice to share some of the most private, intimate details of their life. These memories are often wrought with shame, guilt, and paralyzing fear. As a result of sharing their story and beginning to heal from those experiences, they receive hope and healing. We are sharing small pieces of these stories, in a confidential manner, as a reminder of the impact of our work.


### **Therapy**

Trauma focused, evidence based treatment for child victims of severe physical and/or sexual abuse, or trafficking and their non-offending caregivers at no cost to the client or family.


### COPE

## Safe Harbor by the Numbers





## **INCOME LEVEL**


