Library Re-Opening February 22nd

Stratford, ON, February 16 – Starting Monday February 22nd, the library will be re-opening its doors to the public. During opening hours, customers can browse the collection, use public computers, and access free Wi-Fi without appointment. Contactless curbside pickup of holds will still be available during regular hours. Additionally, the MakerSpace will be open by appointment only due to physical distancing restrictions.

The Library is taking every precaution to ensure the health and safety of staff and the public. Increased cleaning and physical distancing protocols are in place to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. Visitors are required to wear a mask or face covering as per requirements by the Huron Perth Public Health. If you do not own a mask, the library will have them available.
