- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing an individual who files a document using the system of electronic filing and case management established by the Court of Appeals to request 4 5 that the document be sealed in a certain manner; requiring the clerk to temporarily 6 seal a certain document pending a certain court determination or for a certain period 7 of time; requiring the court to issue a certain order under certain circumstances; 8 requiring the clerk to make a certain document available to the public under certain 9 circumstances; and generally relating to the system of electronic filing and case management established by the Court of Appeals. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 2 (3) STATING WHETHER THERE IS A COURT ORDER TO SEAL THE 3 DOCUMENT IN EFFECT AND, IF SO, IDENTIFYING THAT ORDER; AND
- 4 (4) IF THERE IS NO COURT ORDER IN EFFECT TO SEAL THE 5 DOCUMENT, INCLUDING A MOTION TO SEAL THE DOCUMENT.
- 6 (B) IF AN INDIVIDUAL SUBMITS A MOTION TO SEAL A DOCUMENT UNDER 7 THIS SECTION, THE CLERK SHALL TEMPORARILY SEAL THE DOCUMENT PENDING 8 THE COURT'S ACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- 9 (C) (1) IF THE COURT DETERMINES THAT THE DOCUMENT SHOULD BE 10 SEALED, THE COURT SHALL ISSUE AN ORDER THAT THE DOCUMENT BE SEALED.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
