INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS
NEW YORK, 16 DECEMBER 1966

PERU: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4 (3)¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Treaty Section of the Office of Legal Affairs, United Nations Secretariat, and, in accordance with article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, bearing in mind what is stated in note verbale LA 41 TR/2017/IV-4/Peru/1, dated 1 March 2017, has the honour to report the following:

- By Supreme Decree No. 003-2024-PCM, dated 10 January 2024, the Government of Peru declared a state of emergency, for a term of 60 calendar days beginning on 11 January 2024, in the following districts and provinces:

- The state of emergency was declared in view of the increase in public insecurity and in the incidence of offences such as illicit drug trafficking, trafficking in persons and illegal mining, which jeopardize the enjoyment and protection of the fundamental rights of citizens, and in view of the need to take measures to maintain law and order.
- During the state of national emergency, the constitutional rights relating to liberty and security of person, inviolability of the home, and freedom of assembly and movement in the territory, included in articles 9, 12, 17 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, are suspended.
