- Participant numbers for Wiki Loves Monuments and Wiki Loves Earth constantly declining
- Many Commons cats of Austrian villages mostly consist of pictures of monuments
- Hardly any incentive to add information about villages in Wikipedia and Commons, due to various reasons

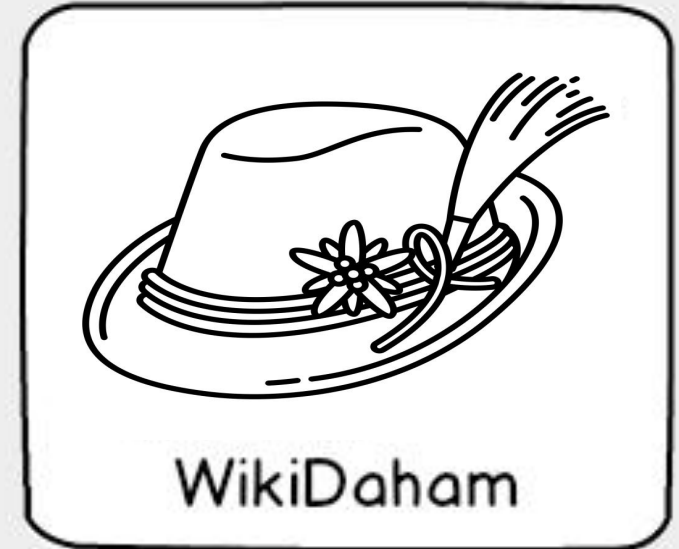
WikiHeimat as a platform



- Create a new platform that will serve as the central framework for contests and projects in Austria for years to
- Using WikiHeimat as a framework to support topics and projects specific to a certain region or province
 - E.g.: Tyrolean Art Cadastre
- Recycling projects like WLM and WLE within this framework
- Foster cooperation with other organisations like OSM
- Include smaller wikis for topics that might not be relevant to Wikipedia (RegioWiki.at, breweries, etc.)
