In April of 2000, CollabNet received \$35 million in funding from a number of leading venture capital firms and technology companies. Venture capital firm Bowman Capital led CollabNet's Series B financing round. The Company also received strategic investments from major hardware, software, and services companies, including: Hewlett-Packard (NYSE: HWP), Intel Capital, Niku Corporation (NASDAQ: NIKU), Novell, Inc. (NASDAQ: NOVL), Opus360 (acquired by Artemis International Solutions Corporation) (OTCBB: AMSI), Oracle Corporation (NASDAQ: ORCL), Sun Microsystems, Inc. (NASDAQ: SUNW), and Turbolinux, Inc. Initial investor, Benchmark Capital, also participated in this financing round. In addition, WR Hambrecht + Co. and Marc Andreessen invested in the company.

In December of 2002, CollabNet received \$13 million in funding. The Series C financing round was led by venture capital firm Norwest Venture Partners. CollabNet also received strategic investments from: Benchmark Capital, Intel Capital, NTT Leasing Co., Ltd., and Oracle Corporation.

In July 2005, CollabNet raised \$9.5 million in funding. The Series B1 financing was supported by Benchmark, Industry Ventures, Intel, Norwest Venture Partners, and WR Hambrecht.
