To ensure this licensing is fair and nondiscriminatory, the terms are as follow:

Technology and Patent License Agreement

Initial License Fee:	\$10,000
Per Product	5% of selling price of Product
For example	The licensing fee on a \$10 product would be \$.50

Under the License, Lucent will provide SPW Block Diagrams, Design Notes and up to 20 hours of consulting services relating to technology essential to the practice of the referenced standard at the Lucent Technologies facility or by telephone, as needed, upon receipt of the Initial License Fee under the Technology and Patent License Agreement.

This declaration does not grant a license or any other rights with respect to Lucent's Intellectual property.
