Subject: Intellectual Property Statement Regarding Broadcom Corporation Submission

Dear Mr. Kerry:

This letter is to notify the IEEE 802.11 Working Group that Broadcom Corporation will license any patents that have or may issue to Broadcom Corporation that relate to a submission to Task Group E entitled "Analysis of Dual Pre-coding for FEC," IEEE 802.11/02-414r0, if such submission is adopted in its entirety and made part of the IEEE 802.11e standard. The license shall: a) extend only to the portion of any product that is fully compliant with the IEEE 802.11e standard; b) be non-exclusive, royalty-free and granted on reasonable and non-discriminatory terms and conditions; c) only include patent claims that would necessarily be directly infringed by the manufacture, sale and implementation of a product solely because of its full compliance with the IEEE 802.11e standard, and for which no technically feasible alternatives exist; d) not be offered or shall be terminable by Broadcom Corporation if the requesting party or licensee asserts any intellectual property claim against Broadcom Corporation; and e) not be granted unless a similar royalty-free license to a requesting party's IEEE 802.11 related patents is made available to Broadcom Corporation.
