
This letter will serve to advise the IEEE 802.11 Working Group of Philips Semiconductor's, hereafter Philips, IP statement relating to our proposal for Task Group B:

Philips IP Statement for TGe

Philips will, upon written request of any company (the "requester"), grant it a personal, non-exclusive license on reasonable and non-discriminatory terms (which may include Philips' then current royalty rates and other terms) for only that portion of any product that is fully compliant with the IEEE 802.11e standard, under any existing, pending, and future patents of Philips that would necessarily be directly infringed by the manufacture, sale, and use of the product solely because it is fully compliant with the IEEE 802.11e standard, provided that a similar license under the requester's patents is made available to Philips and any and all licensees of Philips's current and future 802.11e proposals.
