- **Technical**

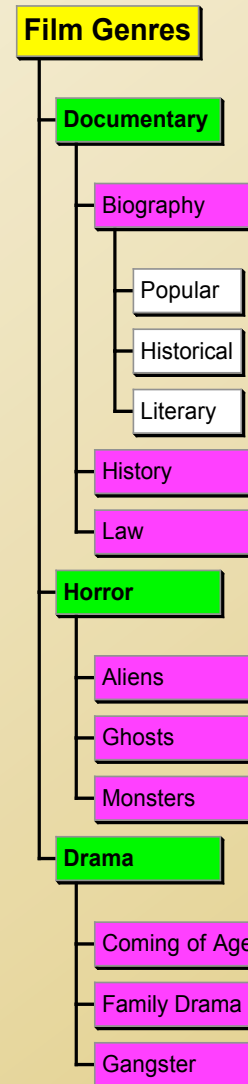


Descriptive Metadata

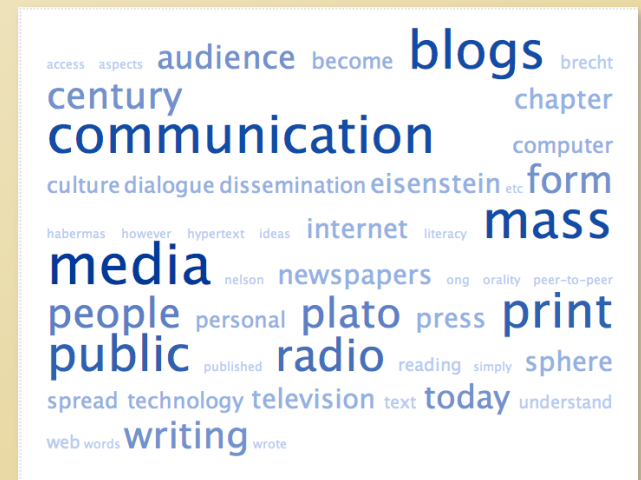
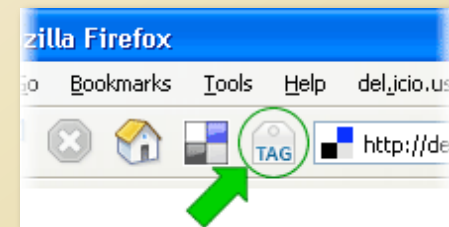
- **Metadata used to describe or identify resources**
- **Taxonomies, data dictionaries and indexes**
- **Folksonomies**



- Taxonomy is a system for organizing concepts and categorizing content
- Expresses hierarchical relationships (parent child)
- Arranged in a tree-like structure
- Dictionary of preferred terminology



- **User generated taxonomies**
- **Freely chosen keywords by the content creator**
- **Social tagging**



Preservation Metadata

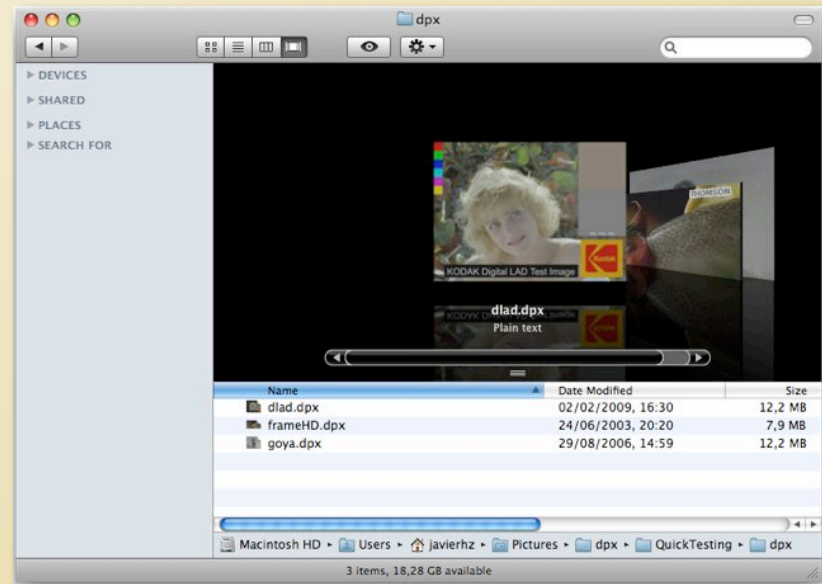
- **Physical condition**
- **Source information**
- **Archival information**
- **Authenticity**



- **Rights management**
- **Version control**
- **Acquisition information**



- **Hardware and software documentation**
- **File formats**
- **Compression information**
- **Color encoding**
- **Encryption information**



Why Should We Care About Metadata?

- According to “*The Digital Dilemma*” the average digital motion picture consists of between 2-10 *petabytes* of data
- Millions of digital objects that need to be organized



Proper Use of Metadata is Important Because ...

- Enhances search retrieval performance
- Provides a way of managing digital objects
- Helps determine authenticity of digital objects
- Key to interoperability between systems
- Key for tracking preservation information



Current Academy Metadata Initiatives

- **Open source digital preservation software tools for digital motion picture materials**
- **Media management cataloging software utilizing metadata standards such as PREMIS and PBCore**



Current Academy Metadata Initiatives

- **Motion picture industry wide metadata survey to identify metadata needs**
- **Analyze existing technical and preservation metadata standards and identify gaps for the cataloging and classification of digital motion picture materials**
