


Age adjusted rate of fatal lab confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 by race/ethnicity group

- Data about persons who identify as American Indian or Alaska Native, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, or other races are not available. Hispanic/Latino includes people of any race.
