

Top five Academy courses in 2022

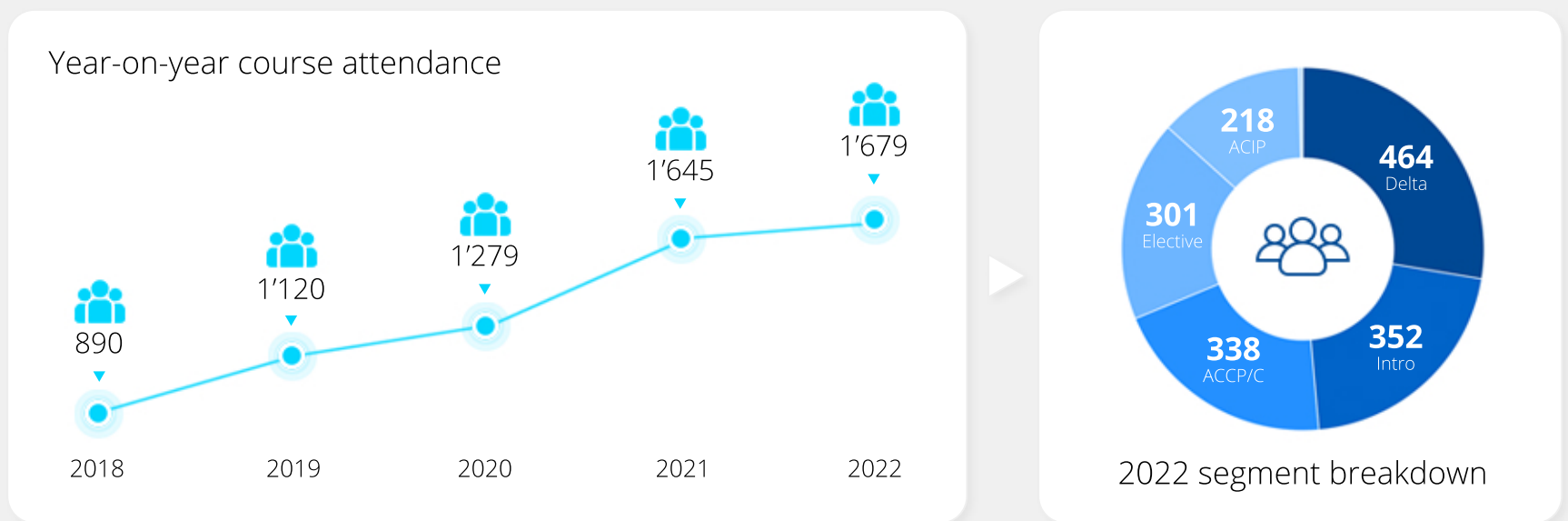


You might think it's too still early to determine this year's top five courses, but with our **upcoming courses already almost fully booked**, I think we can draw some fairly safe conclusions.
