Departmental Honors in Special Education requires the following sequence of courses totaling 9 credit hours:

EDSP 3700 (HON)	Introduction to Special Education (3)
EDSP 4990 (HON)	Education Honors Capstone for a total of six credit hours spread out over at least
	two semesters (across four semesters is recommended)

The goals of Departmental Honors in Special Education are to provide honors students with in-depth research experiences in an area of interest and to provide faculty the opportunity to involve honors students in faculty research.

ESP 4990 has the prerequisite of EDSP 3700. During EDSP 3700, the student will learn about the Clemson University special education faculty members and their research areas. In 3700, the student will write a research paper on a predetermined topic. Upon faculty review, the student will work with a designated faculty member to develop a plan for completing Honors requirements through EDSP 4990. The plan must be approved by the faculty member prior to enrolling in EDSP 4990.
