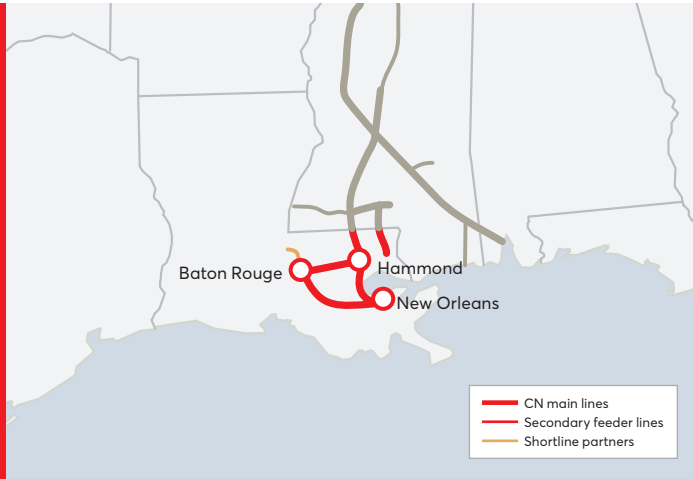

TOP THREE COMMODITIES



At the southern terminus of CN's North American network, Louisiana handles growing volumes of traffic, notably in the triangle formed by Hammond, Baton Rouge and the Port of New Orleans. CN's major yards are in Baton Rouge, Geismar and Harahan (Mays Yard) outside of New Orleans. At Mays Yard, CN connects to the New Orleans Public Belt Railroad, which links the city's six Class I railroads. CN also has a modern intermodal facility in New Orleans. Amtrak's *City of New Orleans* service terminates in New Orleans.

Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested more than US\$550 million in rail capacity, safety and intermodal improvements on its Class I railroad system in Louisiana. These capital investments are supporting a stronger, more vibrant economy in Louisiana through transportation that is safer and more efficient. The expansion program included double-tracking sidings at the Convent Marine Terminal, replacing the Baton Rouge Bridge, and rebuilding the McComb Spillway Bridge. The maintenance program focused on the replacement of rail and ties, plus upkeep of public crossings, bridges, culverts, signal systems and other track infrastructure.

Community Investments

In 2023, CN contributed to several Louisiana-based organizations, including:

LOUISIANA ART AND SCIENCE MUSEUM Housed along CN's tracks in the Yazoo and Mississippi Valley Railroad Company Depot in Baton Rouge, the museum seeks to enhance the understanding and appreciation of art and science by presenting educational and entertaining experiences that encourage discovery, inspire creativity, and foster the pursuit of knowledge. CN's contribution supported the museum's Seed Hands-On Gallery and its 60th anniversary gala.

AMERICAN RED CROSS OF LOUISIANA For more than 100 years, the American Red Cross in Louisiana has alleviated human suffering in the face of emergencies. Its members offer aid and resources to others to prevent, prepare for and respond to emergencies through immediate assistance, education, outreach and training. CN contributed toward emergency relief for southern tornadoes and storms.

BOYS TOWN LOUISIANA Boys Town Louisiana opened in 1989, and today meets the needs of youth and families through a variety of Continuum of Care® services. The organization offers diagnostic and assessment services to provide immediate help to youth in dangerous situations. The site has three family homes for adolescents in New Orleans and provides in-home family services to troubled families.

AUDUBON NATURE INSTITUTE The Audubon Nature Institute operates 10 museums and parks dedicated to nature. The Institute serves as an educational resource, environmental guardian, leader in economic development and venue for family entertainment.
