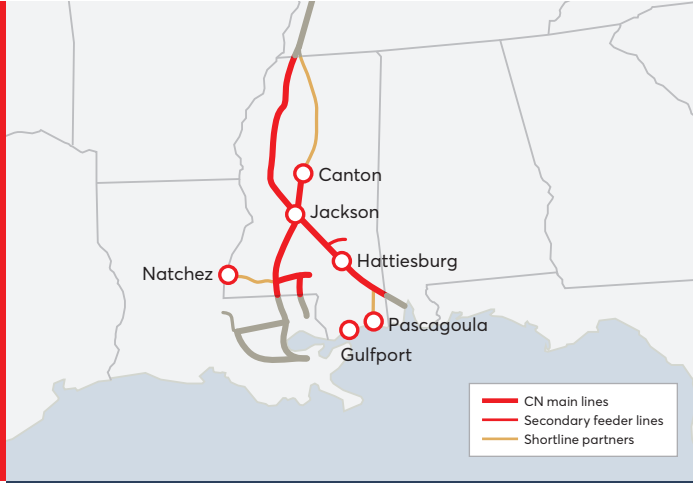

## TOP THREE COMMODITIES



CN's network criss-crosses Mississippi, with a rail yard in Jackson serving as a hub for petroleum headed to the western part of the Magnolia State, coal moving east to Alabama, grain shipping south to the Gulf Coast for export, and chemical products headed north to the Midwest. Intermodal products destined throughout North America are handled through our intermodal terminal in Jackson, where more than 350 CN railroaders live and work. Amtrak's *City of New Orleans* service stops in Jackson at CN's rail yard. CN also has an automotive distribution facility serving the Nissan assembly plant in Canton.

## Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested more than US\$650 million to build and maintain a safe and efficient network in Mississippi and to support our supply chain partners. The program focused on the replacement of rail and ties, as well as maintenance of bridges, public crossings, culverts, signal systems and other track infrastructure.

## Community Investments

In 2023, CN contributed to several Mississippi-based organizations, including:

**AMERICA IN BLOOM** CN EcoConnexions contributed to America in Bloom to promote beautification in Madison by planting trees and shrubs. Throughout the U.S., America in Bloom and CN completed 13 tree-planting projects in 2023. Together, we have planted more than 70,000 trees, shrubs and perennials along our U.S. network since the beginning of our collaboration in 2014.

**MISSISSIPPI'S TOUGHEST KIDS** Camp Kamassa is a camp designed especially for children and adults with special needs.

**MISSISSIPPI OPERATION LIFESAVER (MSOL)** MSOL is a non-profit public safety education and awareness organization dedicated to reducing collisions, fatalities and injuries at road-rail crossings and trespassing on or near railroad tracks. A long-time partner, the CN Police Service provided a donation to celebrate their 100th anniversary.

**HUNGER2HOPE** Hunger2Hope is a non-profit organization in DeSoto County that provides nutritional, emotional, and spiritual support to students whose families are facing hard times. Each weekend during the school year, qualifying students are given a backpack filled with food for each meal during the weekend and encouragement to keep them uplifted for the week to come.

**MISSISSIPPI WILDLIFE REHABILITATION (MWR)** MWR was founded in 1995 to meet the increasing need for wildlife assistance in north Mississippi. MWR is a non-profit organization assisting hundreds of injured and orphaned wild birds. MWR also offers a variety of education programs for community festivals, civic organizations and thousands of school children annually.
