## A BILL

To prohibit certain oil and gas leasing activities on portions of the Outer Continental Shelf, consistent with the President's Outer Continental Shelf moratorium statement of June 26, 1990.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT MORATORIUM.**

4 The Secretary of the Interior shall not conduct any  
5 oil and gas preleasing, leasing, or development activities

1 under the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act in any area  
2 placed under restriction by the President's moratorium  
3 statement of June 26, 1990. This section shall cease to  
4 be effective on January 1, 2001.
