**A BILL**

To amend section 114 of title 17, United States Code, to provide for agreements for the reproduction and performance of sound recordings by webcasters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Webcaster Settlement  
3 Act of 2009”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF AGREEMENTS.**

5 Section 114(f)(5) of title 17, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (D), by striking “2008”  
8 and inserting “2008, the Webcaster Settlement Act  
9 of 2009,”;

10 (2) in subparagraph (E)(iii), by striking “to  
11 make eligible nonsubscription transmissions and  
12 ephemeral recordings”; and

13 (3) in subparagraph (F), by striking “February  
14 15, 2009” and inserting “at 11:59 p.m. Eastern  
15 time on the 30th day after the date of the enactment  
16 of the Webcaster Settlement Act of 2009”.
