A BILL

To amend title 17, United States Code, to extend expiring provisions of the Satellite Television Extension and Localism Act of 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Satellite Television Ac-
5 cess Reauthorization Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION.**

7 Chapter 1 of title 17, United States Code, is amend-
8 ed—

9 (1) in section 111(d)(3)—

1 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
2 (A), by striking “clause” and inserting “para-
3 graph”; and

4 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking
5 “clause” and inserting “paragraph”; and
6 (2) in section 119—

7 (A) in subsection (c)(1)(E), by striking
8 “2014” and inserting “2019”; and

9 (B) in subsection (e), by striking “2014”
10 and inserting “2019”.

11 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION OF LICENSE.**

12 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 119 of title 17, United
13 States Code, as amended in section 2, is amended by add-
14 ing at the end the following:

15 “(h) TERMINATION OF LICENSE.—This section shall
16 cease to be effective on December 31, 2019.”.

17 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 107(a) of
18 the Satellite Television Extension and Localism Act of
19 2010 (17 U.S.C. 119 note) is repealed.
