3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Unemployment Trust
5 Fund Accountability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. STATE REPORT ON REPAYMENT OF DEBTS TO UN-**
2 **EMPLOYMENT TRUST FUND.**

3 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, each State with an outstanding balance in ex-
5 cess of \$1,000,000,000, as of January 1, 2023, of ad-
6 vances from the Federal unemployment account in the
7 Unemployment Trust Fund under section 1201 of the So-
8 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1321) shall submit to Con-
9 gress and the Secretary of Labor a report detailing how
10 such State intends to repay such advances.
