A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Medical
5 Services for Children Reauthorization Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF GRANTS FOR EMERGENCY**

7 **MEDICAL SERVICES FOR CHILDREN.**

8 Section 1910(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42
9 U.S.C. 300w-9(d)) is amended by striking “and
10 \$22,334,000 for each of fiscal years 2020 through 2024”
11 and inserting “\$22,334,000 for each of fiscal years 2020
12 through 2024, and \$24,334,000 for each of fiscal years
13 2025 through 2029”.
