



- Total number of operators 8,542
- Operators not connected to a facility 2,386
 (28 percent)
 - Drinking water operators 1,423
 - Wastewater operators 1,225
 - Dual certified operators (both water and wastewater certificates) 262




Circuit Rider Operators


- A circuit rider is a certified operator who works at more than one drinking water and/or wastewater facility with different owners
- About 200 water and about 200 wastewater operators are circuit riders
- In 2008, circuit riders operated 21 percent of the water and wastewater systems
- Today, circuit riders operate 46 percent of water systems and 36 percent of wastewater systems

Drinking Water Operators/Facilities






% of Facilities by Class






Wastewater Operators/Facilities





% of Facilities by Class






Age Distribution: Drinking Water Operators





Age Distribution: Wastewater Operators





Average Operator Age






Drinking Water Operator Education Level






Wastewater Operator Education Level






Gender of Operators






New Certificates Issued






Water and Wastewater Examinees






Total Examinees and Total Subclass Exams







Overall Exam Passing Rates: DW

Chapter 302 Regulations

System Owner Responsibilities:

- Ensure process control decisions are made by an available operator
- Provide copies of permits to operators
- Respond to reports from operators
- Provide names of available operators to DEP
- Pay annual service fee



Chapter 302 Regulations

Operator Responsibilities:

- Suitably operate and maintain facility to comply with rules, regulations, and permits
- Follow Standard Operating Procedures unless identified as an available operator
- Provide report to system owner concerning problems and/or violations




Op Cert Program Compliance

Environmental Facility Application Compliance Tracking System (eFACTS) is the database for the Operator Certification Program that provides:


- List of each system's operators
- System operator certification type required class and subclass(es)
- Circuit rider information
- Links the operators to systems
- History of each operator's certification

Op Cert Program Enforcement

- Field staff evaluate compliance during inspections
- Central Office tracks fee payments and Available Operator Report compliance
- Potential enforcement actions:
 - Notice of Violation or Summary Citation
 - Field Order/COA/Administrative Order
 - Penalties (if in violation of an Order)
 - Suspension or revocation of certificate

Op Cert Program Enforcement

- Draft compliance and enforcement technical guidance document – publish in June 2015 for violations of Chapter 302 regulations
- Severity of a violation under Chapter 302 often depends on subsequent violation of water or wastewater program regulations
