***1a. Considers that the values listed in Article 2 TEU should take into account the historical, cultural and constitutional background of the Member State concerned; recalls that the competences of all EU institutions are strictly defined in the Treaties and that in all matters not delegated to the EU, competences remain with the Member States; stresses that it is unacceptable to muddle together different procedures, such as infringements and references to case-law of the Court of Justice and the European Court of Human Rights, with Article 7 TEU, which has a unique and distinct character; regrets that the procedure is political in nature and that its purpose is to attack the right-wing government; underlines that Hungary has responded clearly and in full to all of Parliament's concerns on several occasions; believes that the Article 7 TEU procedure should be terminated immediately and that Hungary should be exonerated; calls on the Commission to accept Hungary's plan under the Recovery and Resilience Facility;***
