DL. whereas in its recommendation of **20 July 2020** on the **2020** National Reform Programme of Hungary and delivering a Council opinion on the **2020** Convergence Programme of Hungary, the Council recommended *that Hungary should take action to address shortages of health workers and ensure an adequate supply of critical medical products and infrastructure to increase the resilience of the health system, improve access to quality preventive and primary care services, protect employment through enhanced short-time working arrangements and effective active labour-market policies, extend* the duration of unemployment benefits, improve the adequacy of social assistance and ensure access to essential services and *quality education for all;*

DL. whereas in its recommendation of **12 July 2022** on the **2022** National Reform Programme of Hungary and delivering a Council opinion on the **2022** Convergence Programme of Hungary, the Council recommended *continuing the labour-market integration of the most-vulnerable groups, in particular through upskilling, and extending* the duration of unemployment benefits *to* improve the adequacy of social assistance and ensure access to essential services and *adequate housing for all; whereas it recommended improving education outcomes and increasing the participation of disadvantaged groups, in particular Roma, in quality mainstream education and improving access to quality preventive and primary care services;*
