Rebating Incentive-eligible costs of film productions made in Bulgaria

Rebating eligible costs of film productions, including series, is governed by the Film Industry Act and is administered by the National Film Centre Executive Agency.

Incentive-eligible forms of audiovisual works shall be as follows:

- · A feature film having a runtime of over 70 minutes;
- A documentary having a runtime of over 60 minutes or a TV documentary series having an episode runtime of over 40 minutes;
- An animated film or animated series having a total runtime of over 24 minutes;
- A film intended for television or a platform, having a runtime of over 70 minutes or a TV drama having an episode runtime of over 40 minutes;

Qualifying shall be the works that:

- · Meet the cultural test criteria;
- · Are made either wholly or at least partly in the Republic of Bulgaria;
- Are intended for public release and/or broadcast.

Who can apply?

- A producer or a co-producer that has acquired the rights to the screenplay of the work:
- A provider of film production services that has concluded a contract with a producer, who has acquired the rights to the screenplay of the work for the purpose of the production of the said work.

Requirements for the Film-Incentive applicant:

- The applicant shall be a legal person, registered under the Bulgarian law with filmmaking as its scope of activity or under the law of a member state of the European Union, a party to the EEA Agreement or under the law of the Swiss Confederation, or under the law of a third country; in the latter case the registration should have been made two years prior to the Film-Incentive application submission;
- · The applicant shall make an audiovisual work in the required form;
- The applicant shall be entered into the register of the National Film Centre Executive Agency;
- In a five-year period prior to applying under the Film Incentive scheme, the applicant shall have made, completely or partly, at least one audiovisual

work in the required form that has had a theatrical release, or has been broadcast on TV and/or a platform for catalogued audiovisual works accessible to subscribers or has been screened at one international festival at the least:

- In the event of not meeting the aforementioned requirements, the applicant shall be the founder or a legal representative of such a legal person or a decade prior to applying under the Film Incentive scheme should have, in his/her capacity as the said legal person's chief executive or manager, made and/or participated in the production of at least one audiovisual work in the required form;
- Unregistered applicants, including with a branch under the Bulgarian law, shall register prior to the date of receiving the State aid;
- In the event of a coproduction, the applicant shall be the co-producer registered under the Bulgarian law for the purposes of the production of the work:
- In the event of a production, where no co-producer is registered under the Bulgarian law or the law of a member state of the European Union, a party to the EEA Agreement or the Swiss Confederation, eligible to apply under the scheme shall be a foreign producer through a provider of film production services, registered under the Bulgarian law, whereby the latter shall be the Incentive-eligible applicant;
- Eligible applicants under the scheme shall be solely a producer, coproducer or a provider of film production services that meet the criteria for an independent producer.

Incentive-ineligible audiovisual shall be works as follows:

- Reflecting adversely on the Republic of Bulgaria or the Bulgarian nation; undermining the legal norms and the constitutional principles; seeking to incite wars, racism, radical nationalism, religious hatred and national separatism, as well as discrimination;
- Containing pornographic elements; infringing upon or violating the dignity, honour, privacy; inciting, directly of implicitly, aggression and of propagandistic political or religious nature;
- · Sports events, games or competitions;
- Talk shows, reality shows, 'lifestyle' or 'watch live' programmes;
- · Adaytime drama TV show; sitcom series;
- Programmes demonstrating hobbies or projects;
- Promotional and/or commercial audiovisual works regardless of their runtime, format or use;
- Footage for internal purposes unavailable to wider audiences.

Cultural Test criteria

- Cultural, artistic and creative content, employed creative method, plot of the screenplay and portrayal of the central protagonists in the context of the European cultural diversity and values;
- Assessment of creative cooperation and making use of local resources;
- Promotion of Bulgarian culture, social development, historical heritage, traditions and opportunities for tourism;
- A Bulgarian or European architectural, cultural or historical landmark, a place or location, reflecting important Bulgarian or European values;
- Taking innovative approaches and using techniques and technologies in the creative and technical production processes;
- The final film version shall be in a EU's official language.

Eligible shall be costs as follows:

- Up to 25 per cent of the total amount of the eligible costs of goods and services provided within the Republic of Bulgaria by natural and/or legal persons registered under the Bulgarian law;
- Up to 25 per cent of the total amount of the eligible costs of services provided in the Republic of Bulgaria by natural persons registered under the law of a member state of the European Union, a party to the EEA Agreement or of the Swiss Confederation, whose income generated from a source in the Republic of Bulgaria is subjected to final tax under the Bulgarian law;
- Up to a limit of 80% of the overall production budget;
- · Spent entirely in the Republic of Bulgaria.

The terms and conditions of applying for rebating the eligible costs shall be governed by the Implementing Regulation of the Film Industry Act.

A fee is due on submitting the Film Incentive application.
