


- 42% (5,857 out of 13,872) of critical patients who submitted requests for medical evacuation were approved; these include 35% (4,895) who were medically evacuated abroad as of 20 June.

As of 20 June. 2.150 patients (an average of 50 per day) have not been evacuated since the closure of Rafah Crossing, placing further stress on Gaza's few remaining health facilities.




