 <p>Comforting kids</p>	<p>Together with your team, cut and tie snugly fleece blankets for patients in a children's hospital. Seed money: Buy materials for the blankets and activity books for the kids.</p>
 <p>Helping the homeless</p>	<p>Host a community-wide "sleep out" for one night to raise awareness for homelessness and collect donations for a local shelter. Seed money: Promote your event in a local newspaper or a school program book.</p>
 <p>Creating crafts</p>	<p>Gather a group of people to make crafts, featuring words of encouragement, and surprise neighbors or nursing home residents with a little pick-me-up. Seed money: Buy blank card stock, permanent markers and other supplies.</p>
 <p>Teaching others</p>	<p>Hold a workshop for parents to learn how to teach their kids about sharing, saving and spending. Seed money: Buy mini calculators for participants to take home.</p>
 <p>Serving at your church</p>	<p>Help put together a summer community barbecue or Vacation Bible School with your church. Seed money: Purchase food for meals or supplies for outdoor kids' games.</p>
 <p>Improving your school</p>	<p>Launch an after-school snack program for kids who might go to bed hungry. Have other parents help distribute snacks in bags with inspirational messages. Seed money: Buy bags and snacks the school can send home with kids.</p>
