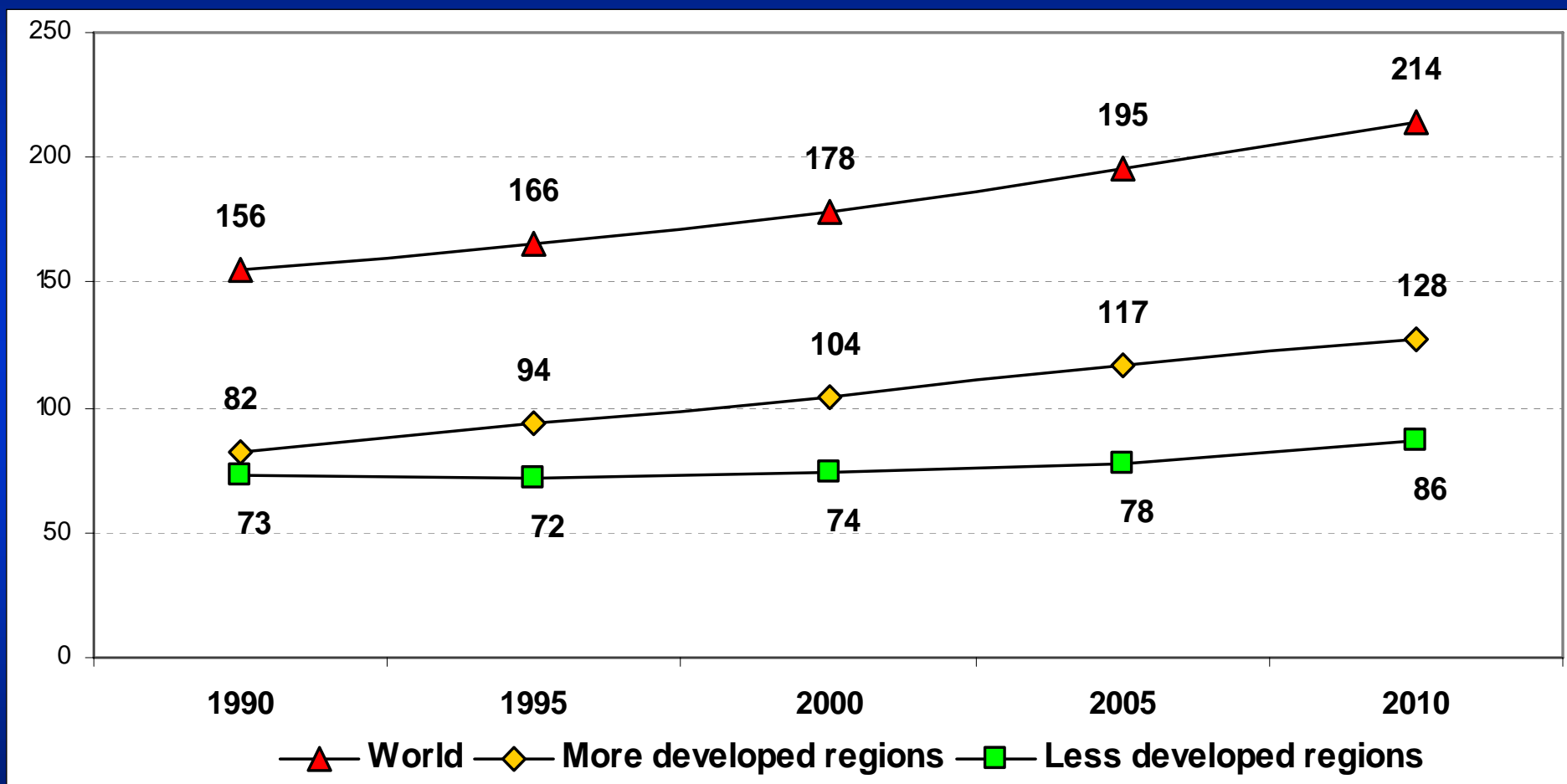

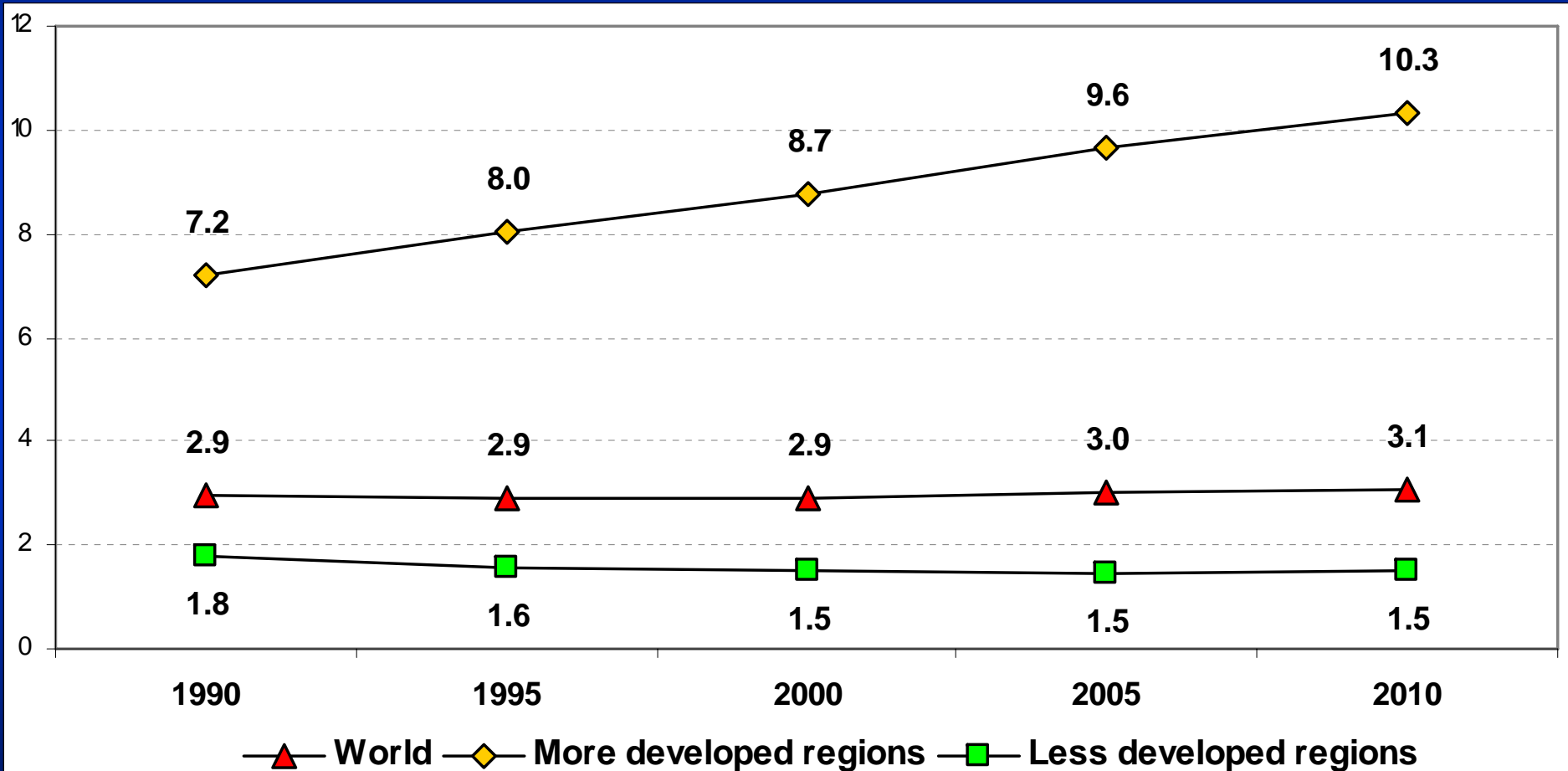
The 2008 Revision: two series of estimates

- **1960-2010 - 212 countries or areas**

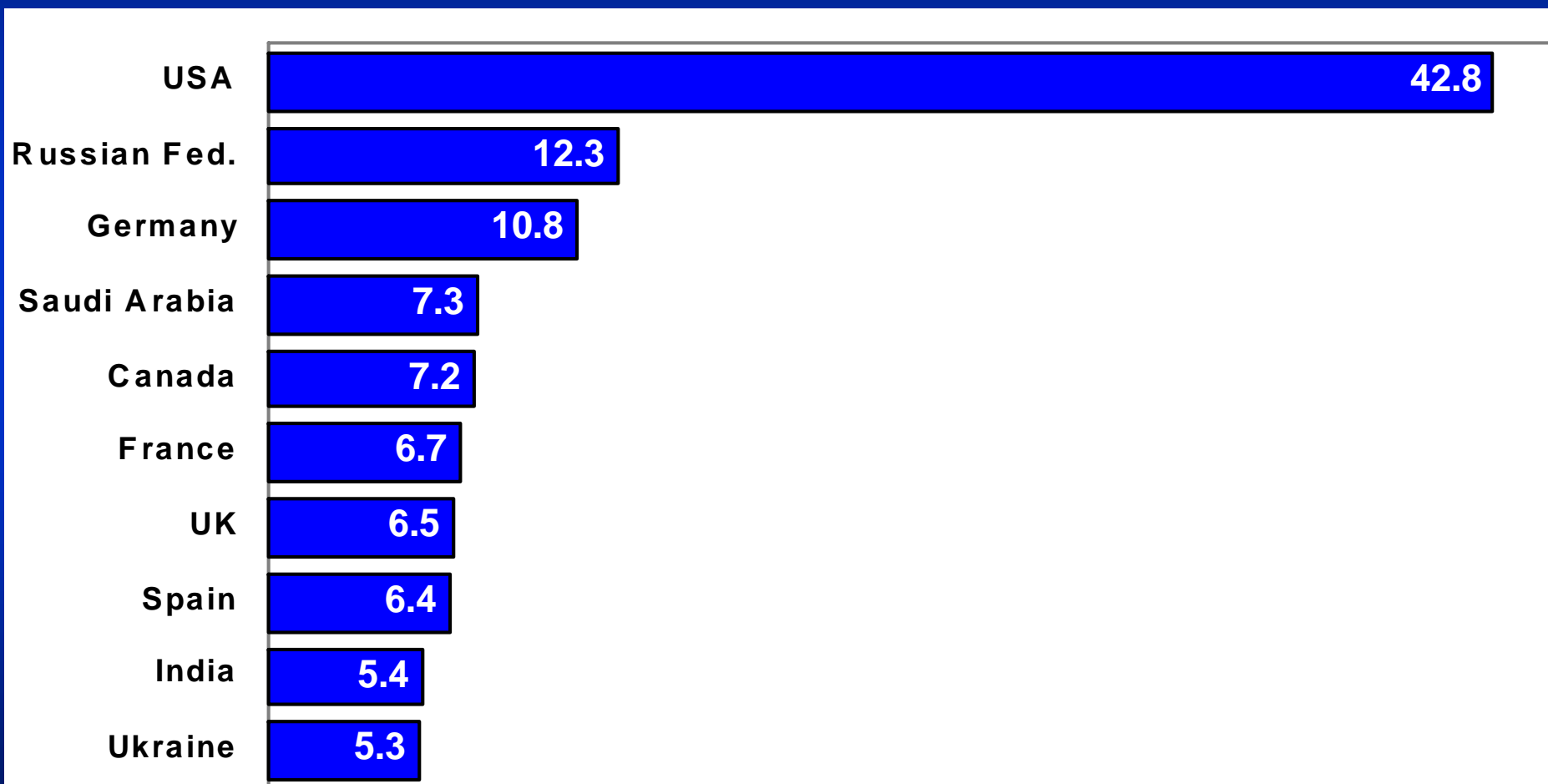
Number of international migrants (millions)



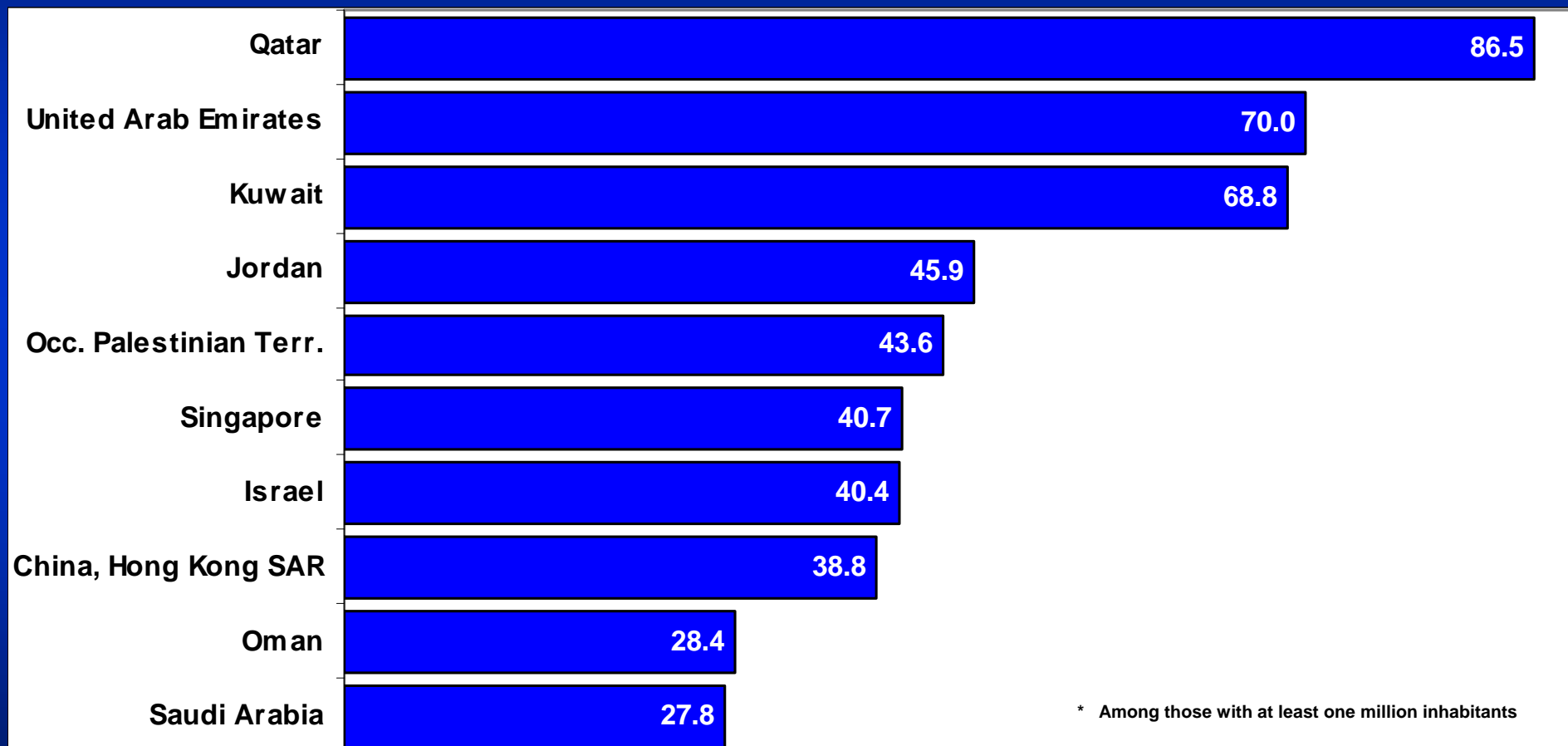
Proportion of migrant stock on total population



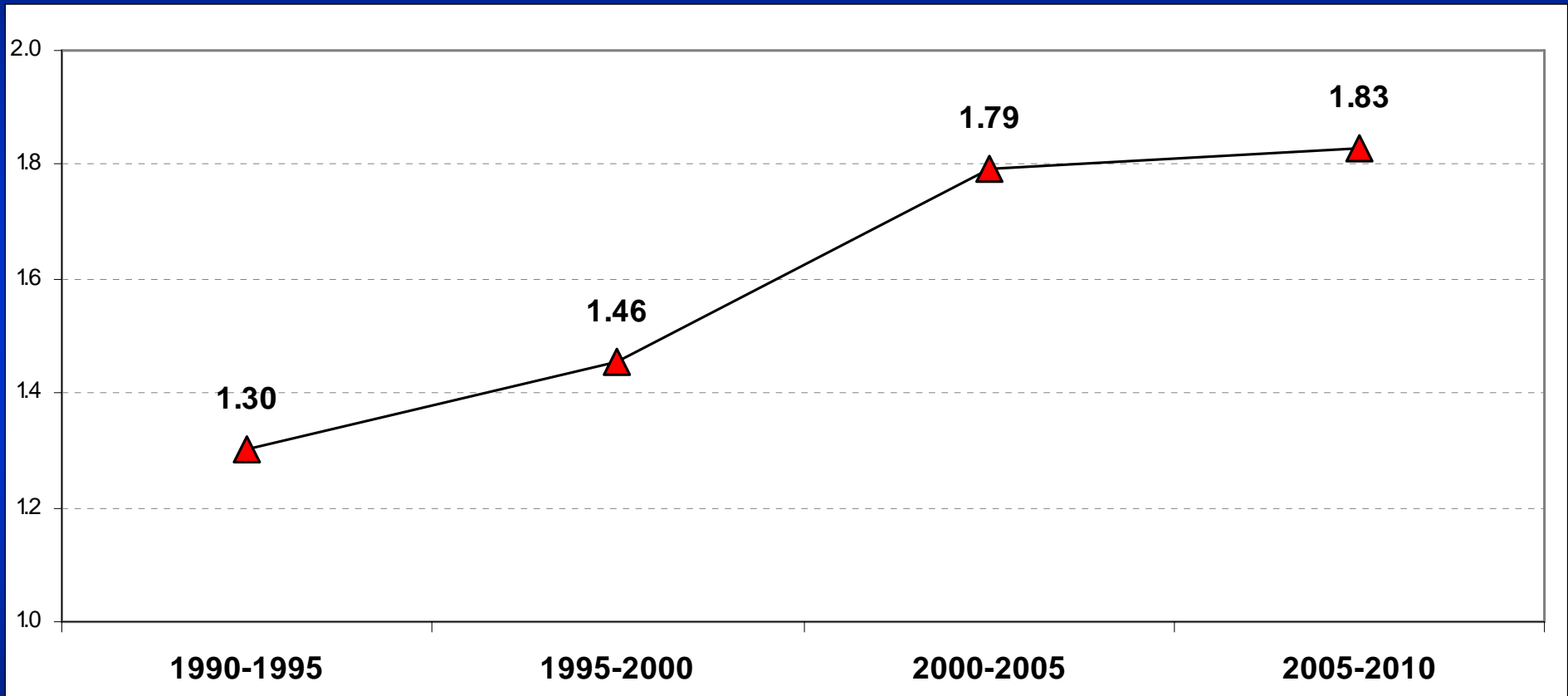
Countries with the largest number of international migrants, 2010 (millions)



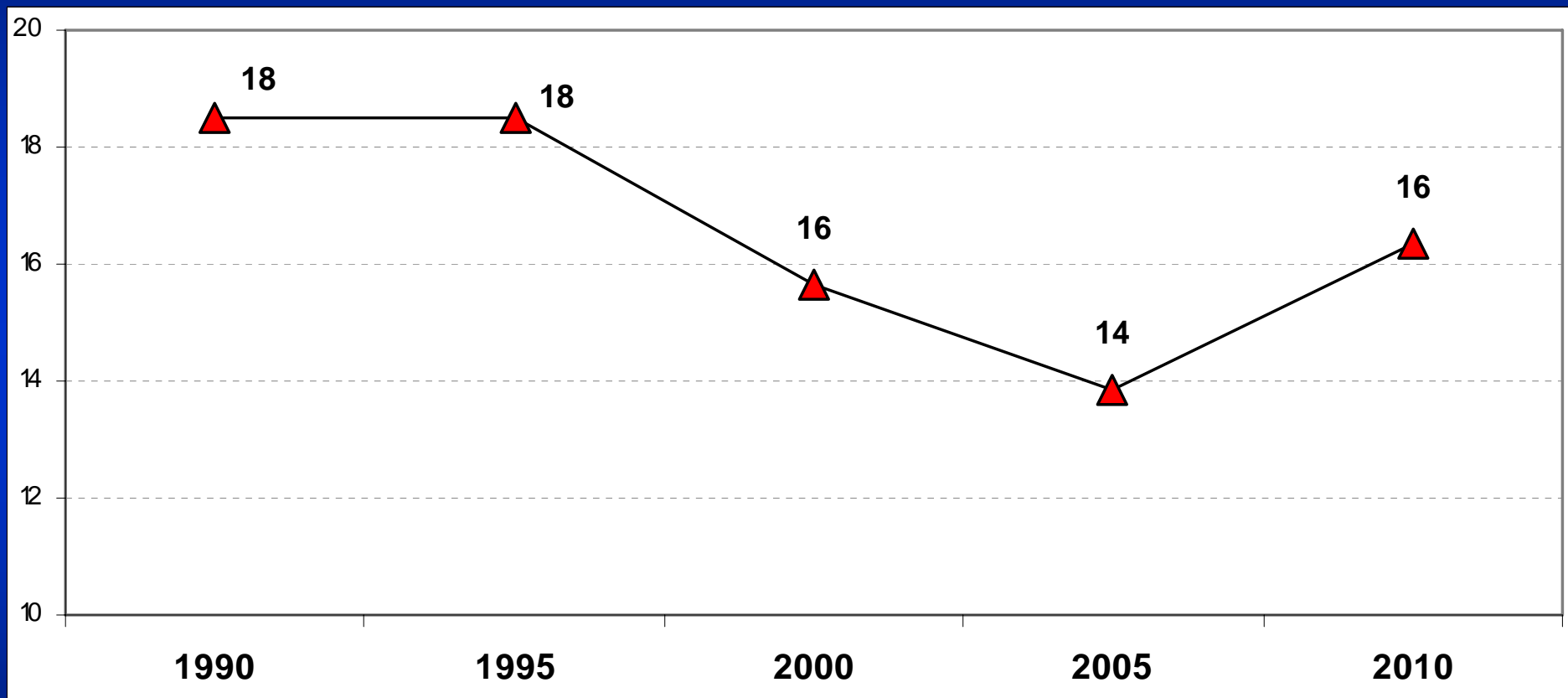
Countries with the highest percentage of international migrants, 2010*



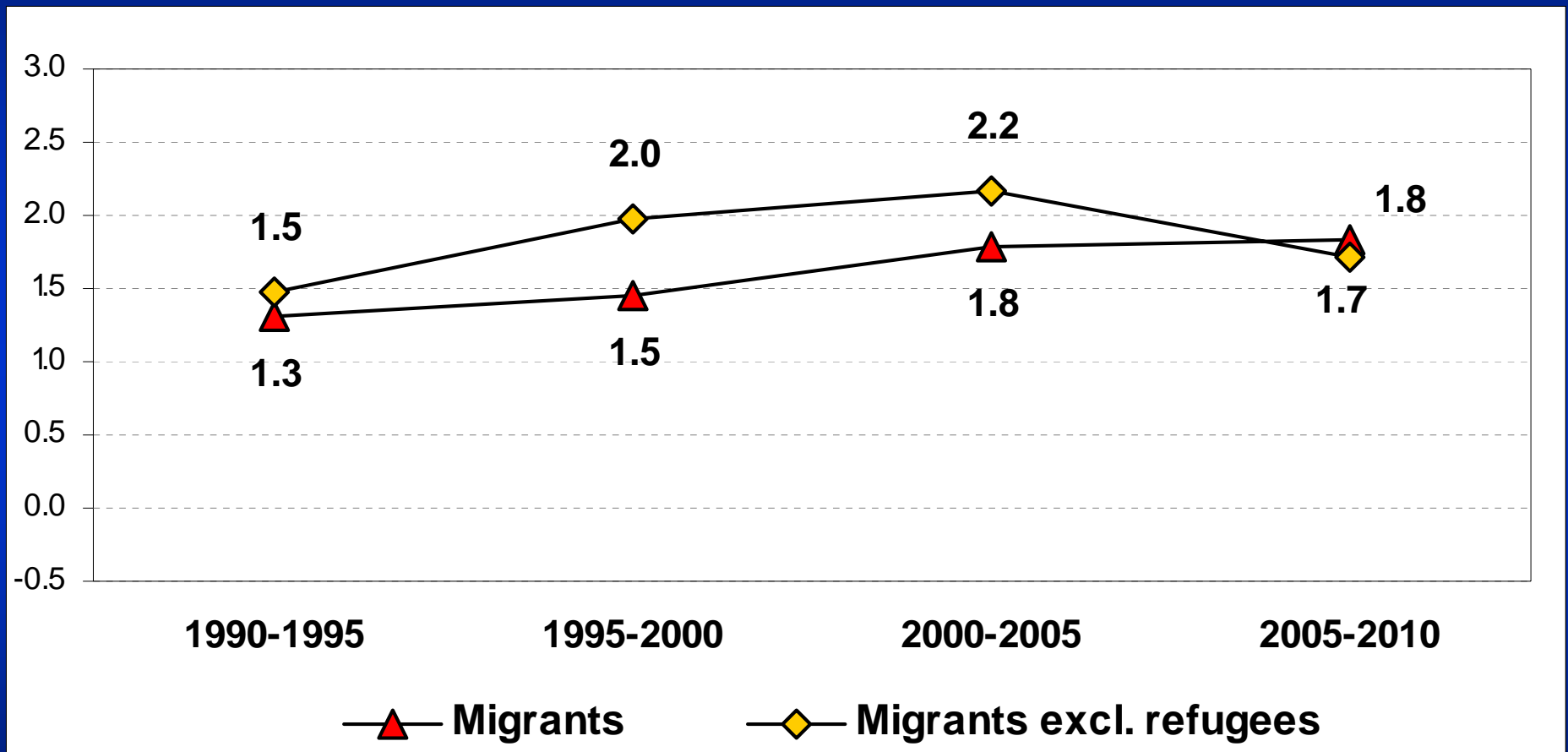
Annual rate of change of migrants



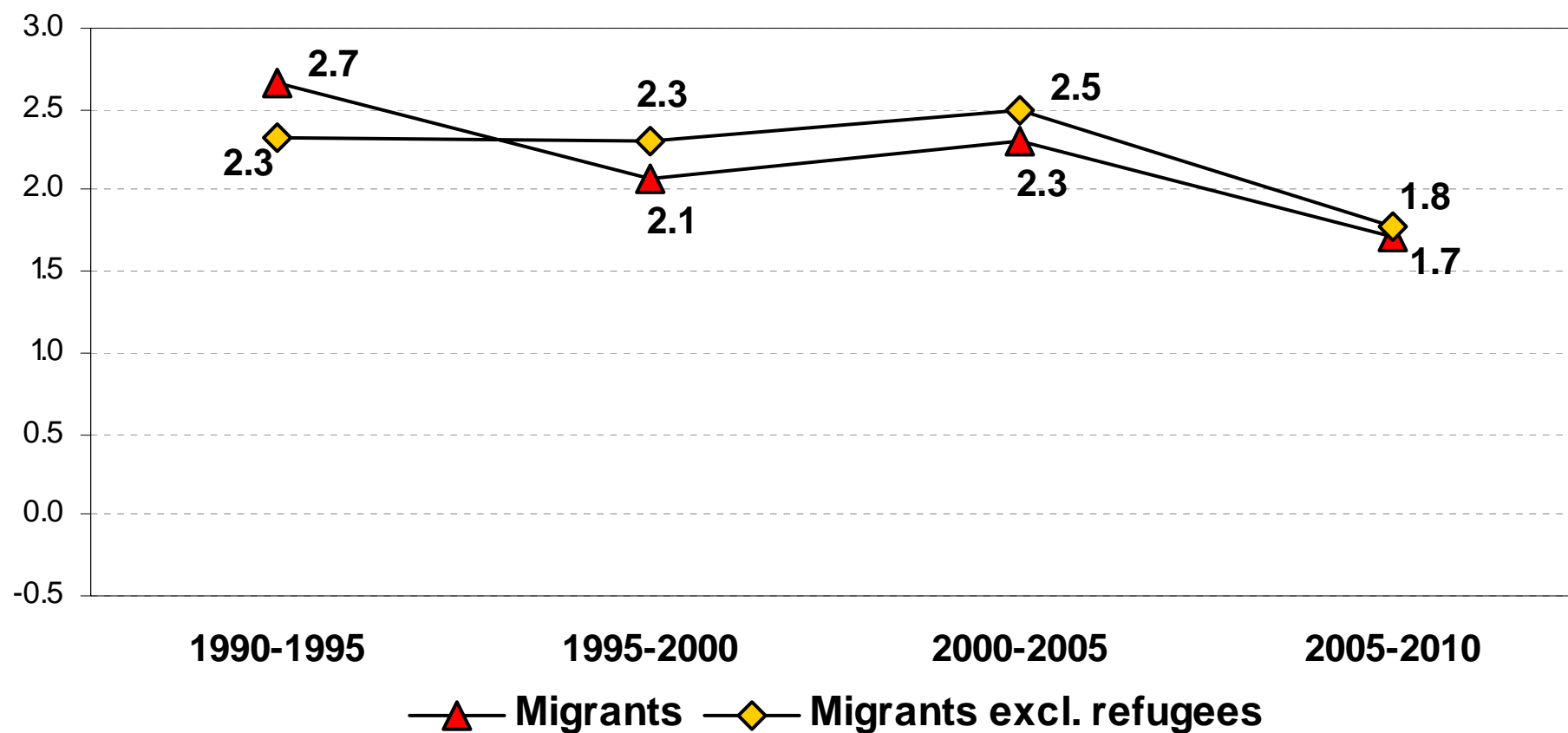
Number of refugees (millions)



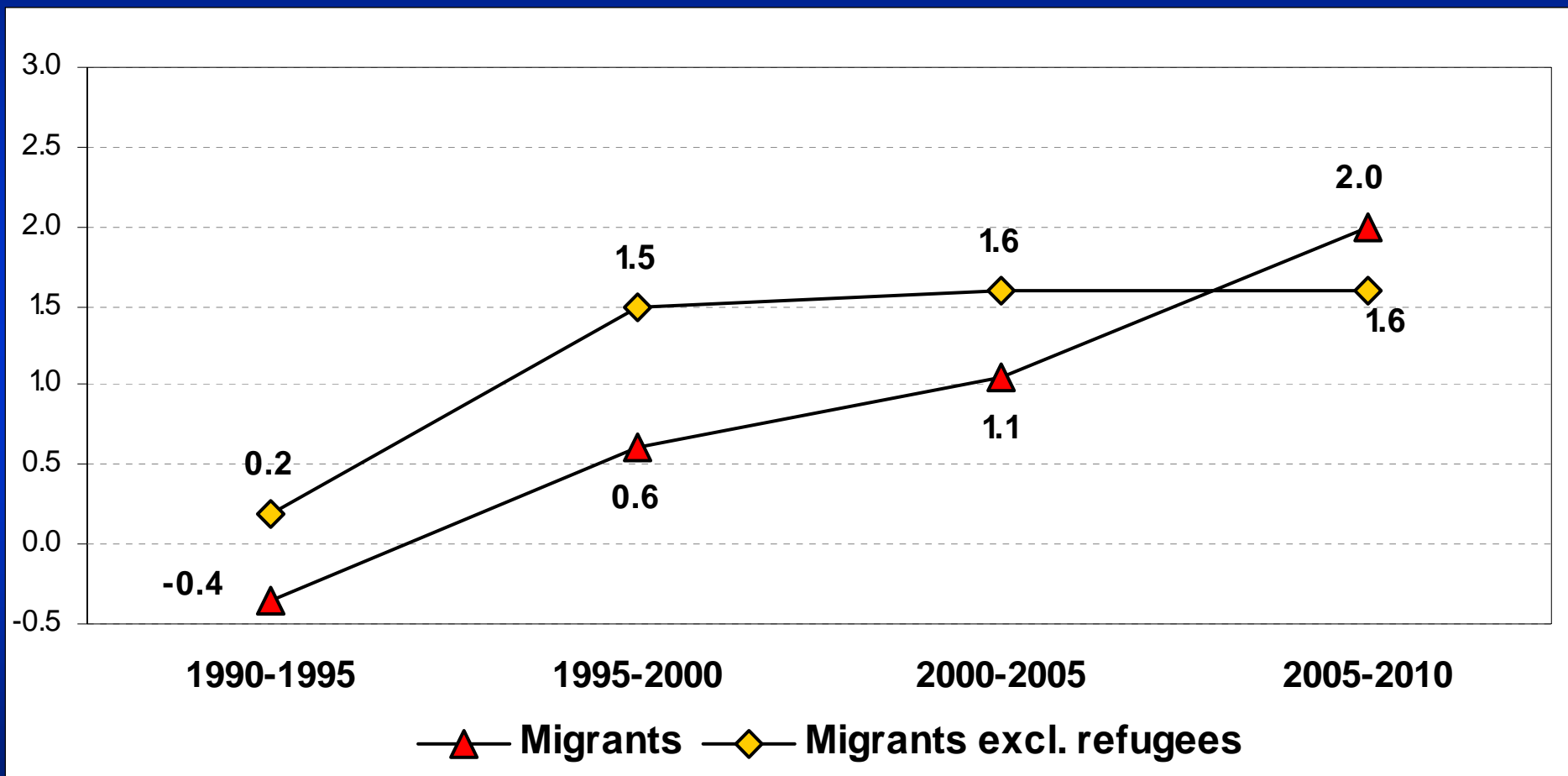
Annual rate of change of migrants



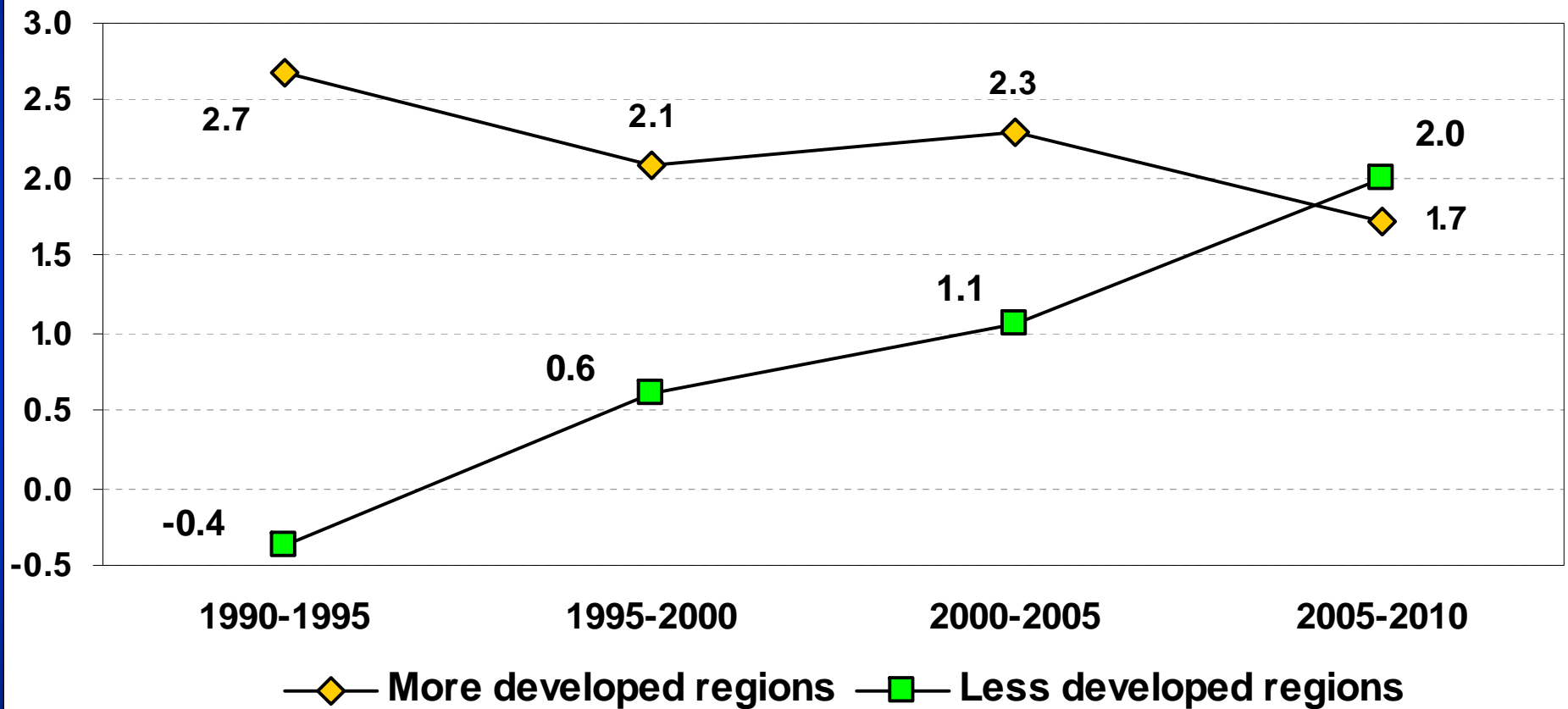
Annual rate of change of migrants More developed regions



Annual rate of change of migrants Less developed regions



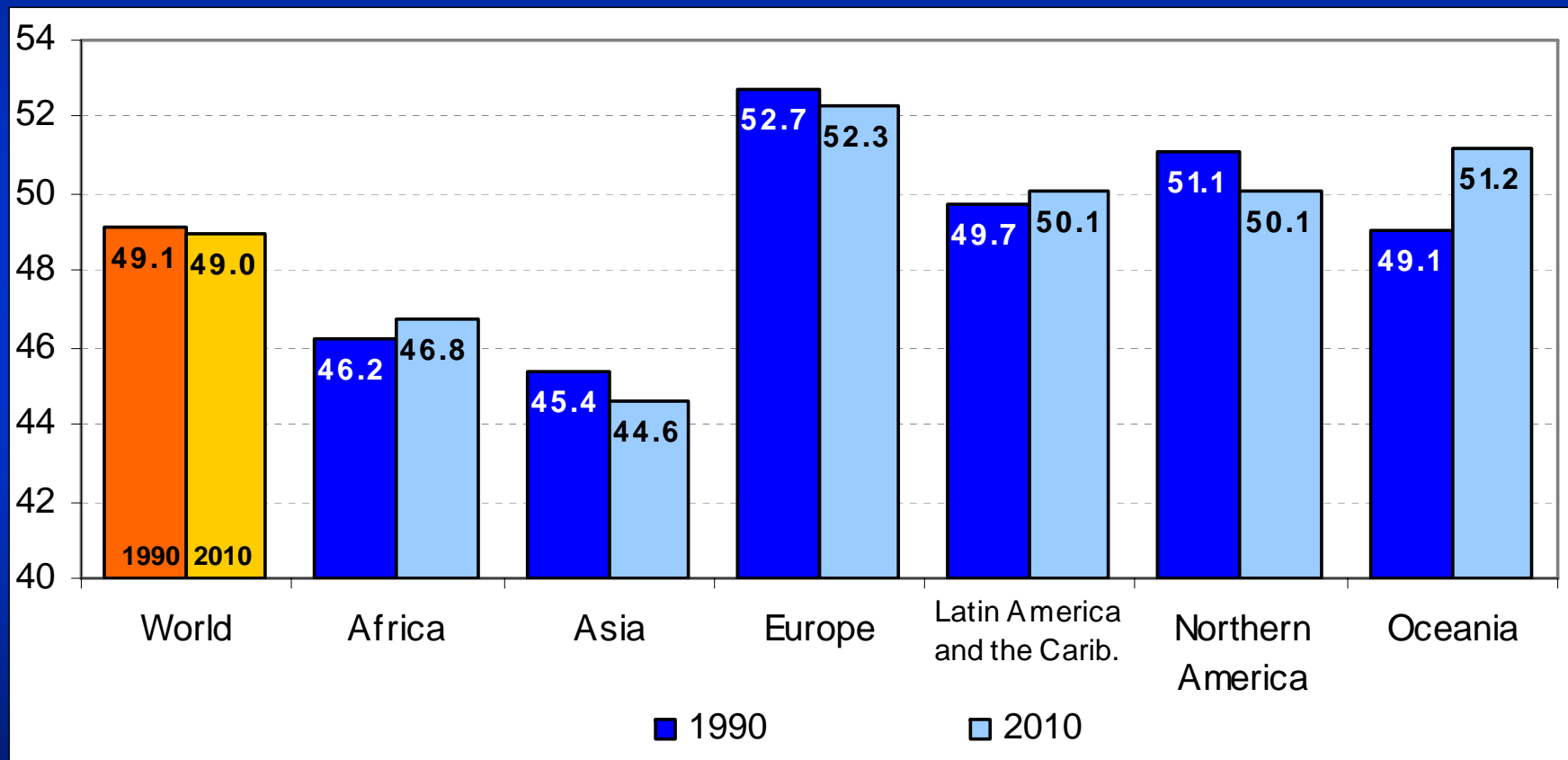

Net migration among the foreign-born 2005-2010

- Increase in the period 2005-2010
195.2 - 213.9 = 18.7 million
- Estimated number of deaths among foreign-born
5.7 million
- Net migration among the foreign-born
18.7 + 5.7 = 24.4 million

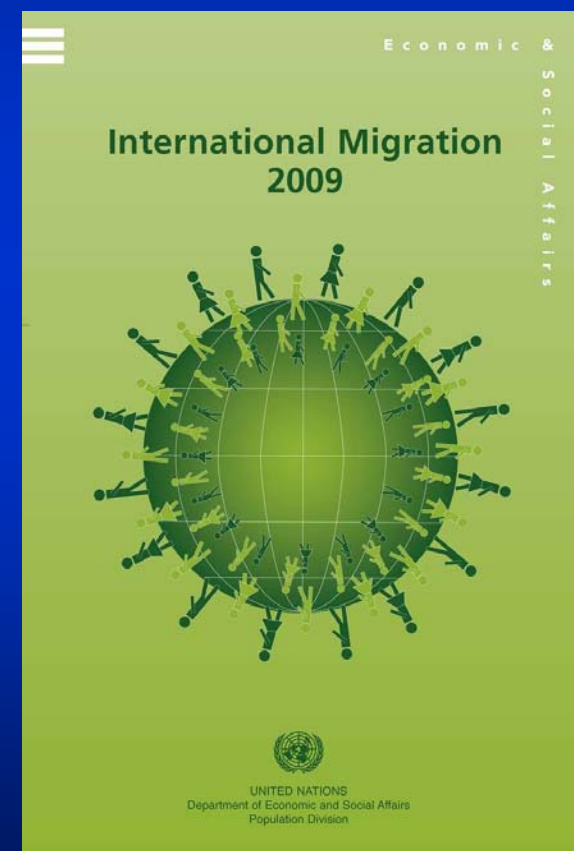
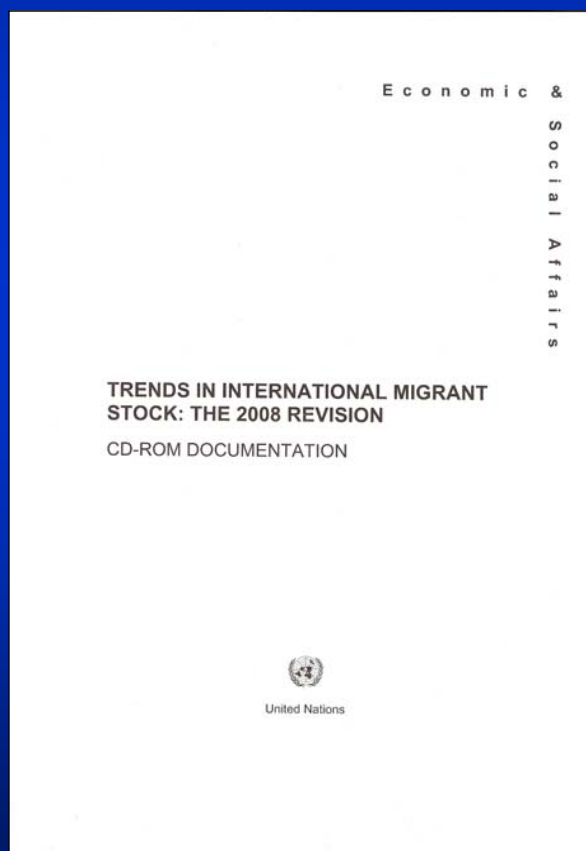
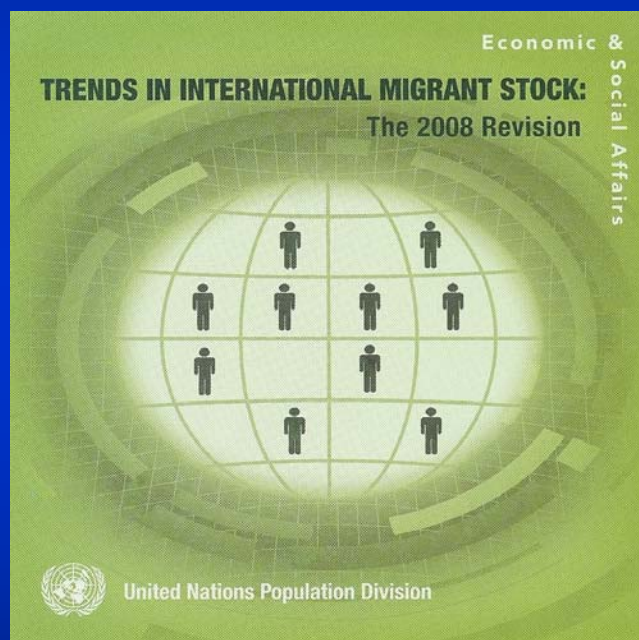
