




### Number of international migrants (millions)




## Proportion of migrant stock on total population




## Countries with the largest number of international migrants, 2010 (millions)




# Countries with the highest percentage of international migrants, 2010\*




#### Annual rate of change of migrants




#### Number of refugees (millions)






### Annual rate of change of migrants More developed regions

## Net migration among the foreign-born 2005-2010


Increase in the period 2005-2010

#### Percentage of female migrants







