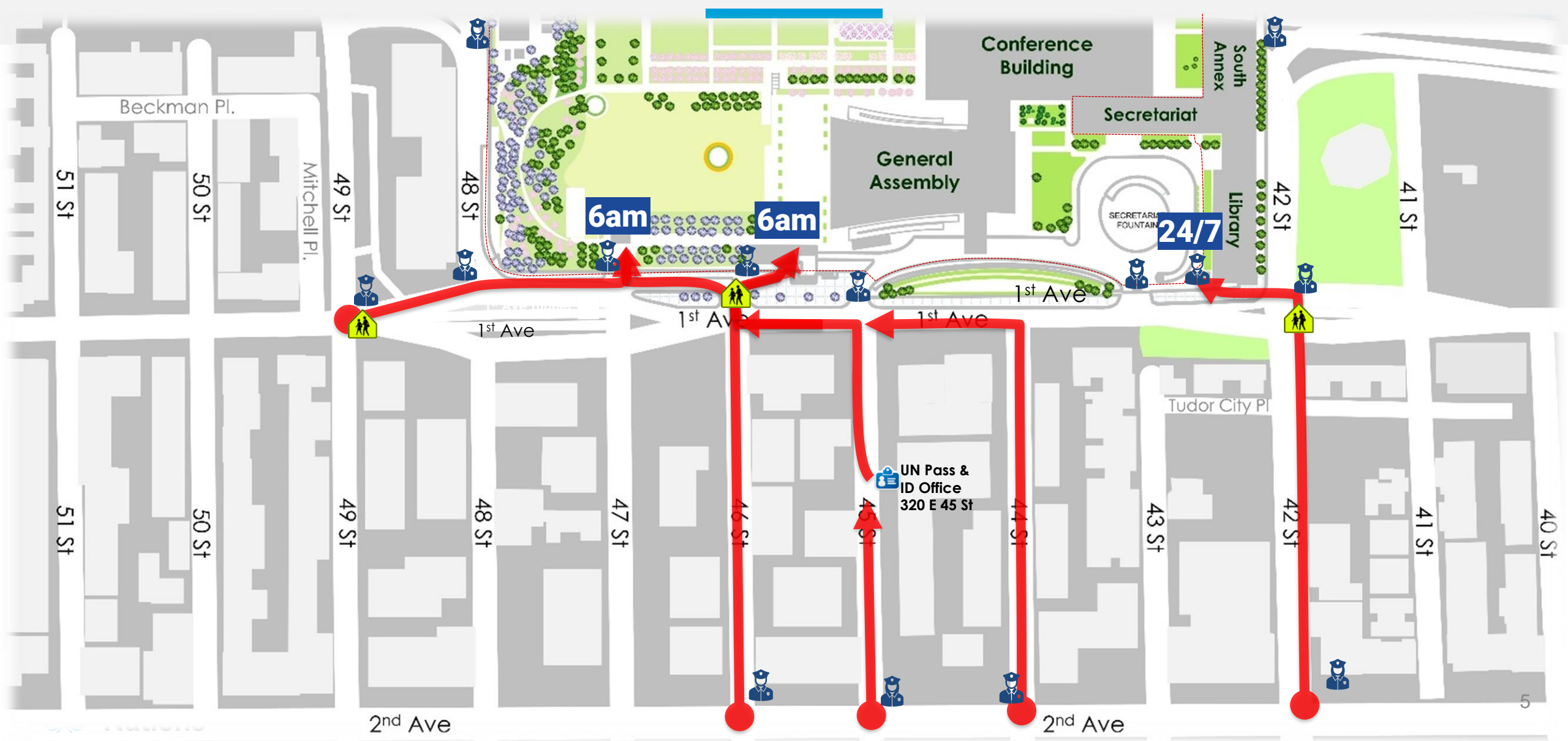

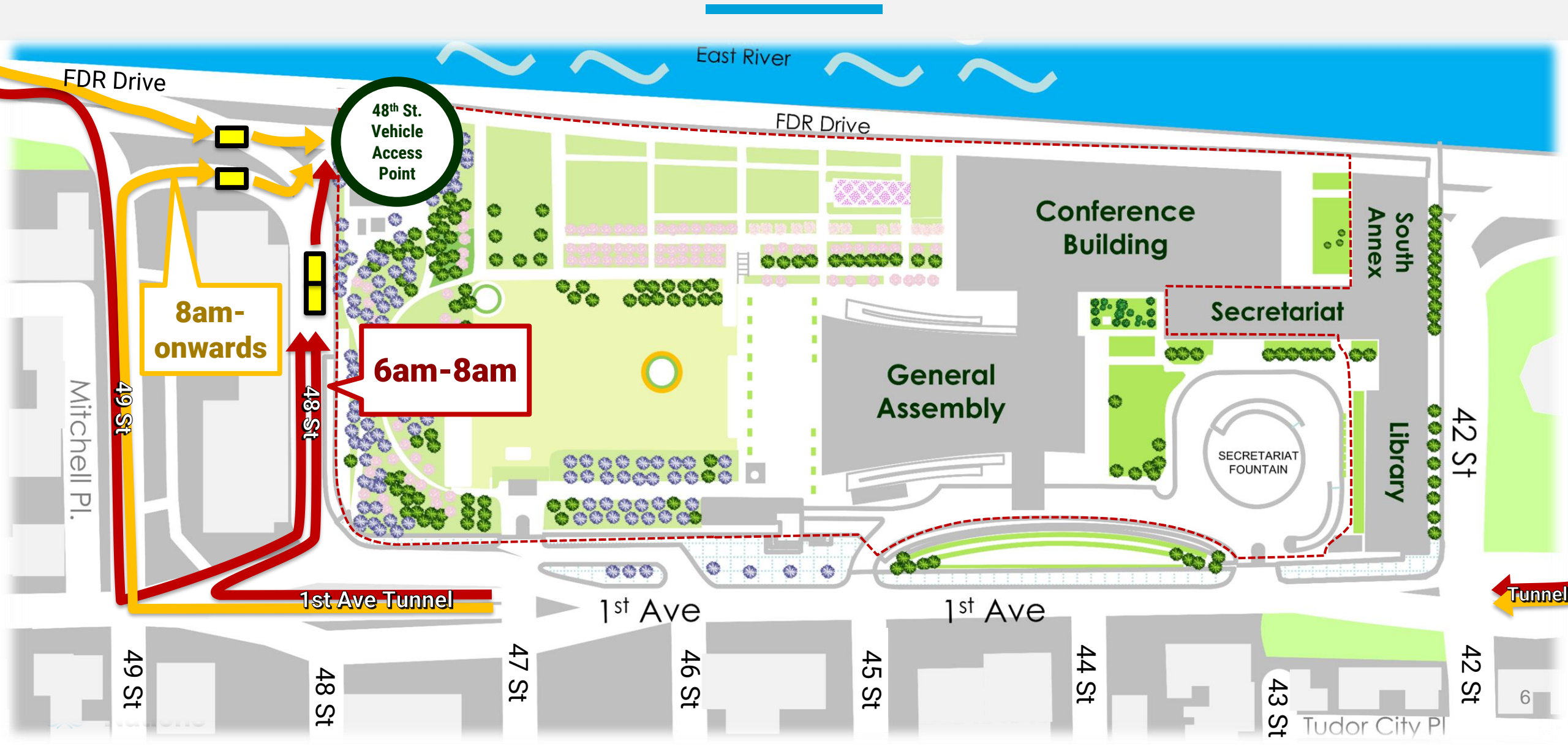


Pedestrian access – outer perimeter

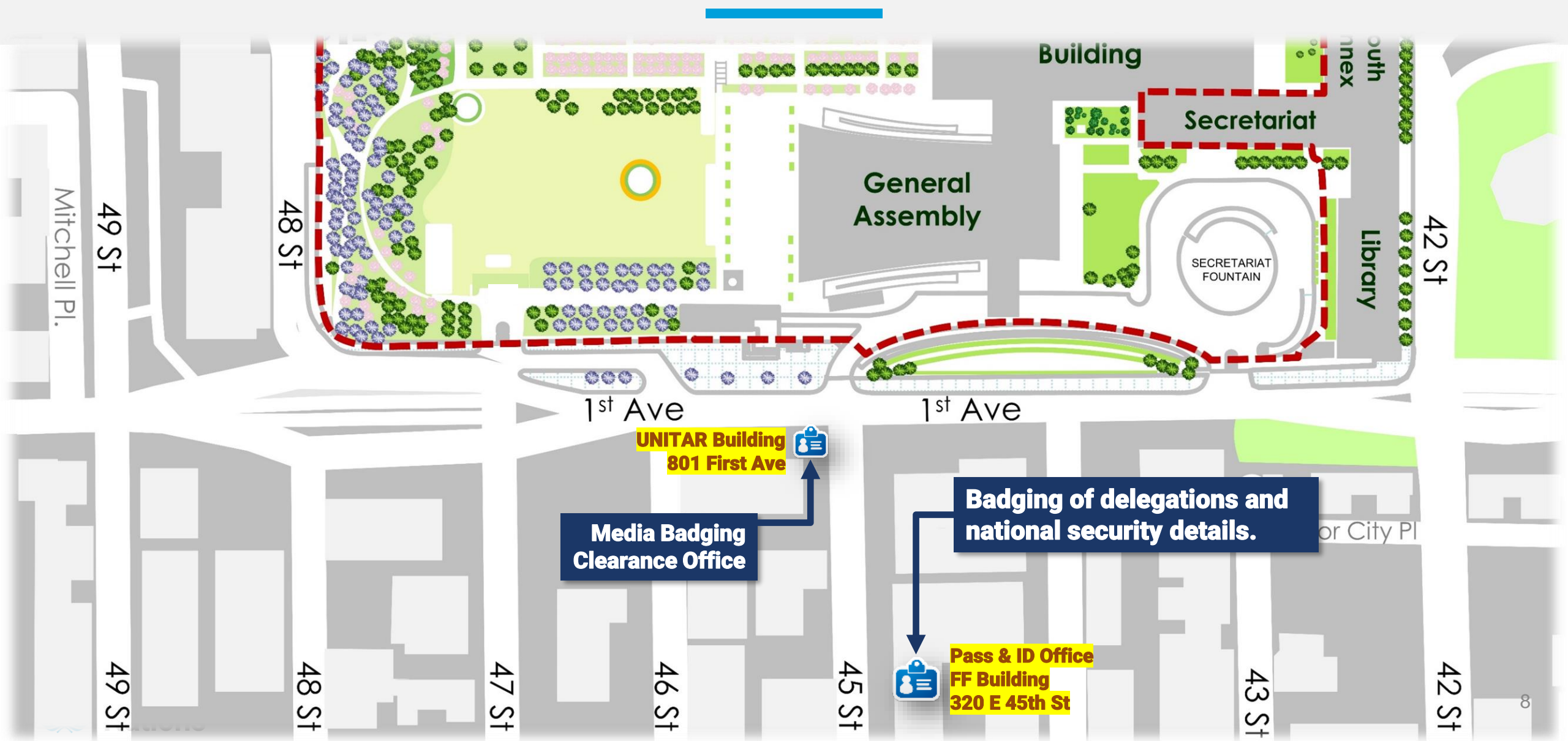

6 + 4 Secondary Passes

Gold



- Allows Delegates to access the GA Hall
- Issued 6 per delegation
- Must be accompanied by a United Nations Delegate's photo ID card.

Blue



- Authorizes Delegates to access the 2nd Floor
- Does Not Allow Access to GA Hall
- Issued 4 per delegation
- Must be accompanied by a United Nations Delegate's photo ID card.

Secondary Passes

Orange



- Allow Access to parts of the 3rd floor CB and First Basement
- Does not allow access to specific meeting rooms, 2nd floor or GA Hall
- Must be accompanied by a United Nations Delegate's photo ID card.

Secondary Passes

INTERPRETER



- Allow Access to 2ND Floor, Restricted Areas, GA Hall
- Must be accompanied by a United Nations Delegate's photo ID card.

PRESS ATTACHE



- Authorizes Delegates to escort up to 5 members of the press to bilateral areas
- Does Not Allow Access to 2nd Floor Including Meeting Rooms.
- Press Attaché must remain with media.
- Must be accompanied by a **Red** United Nations Delegate's photo ID card.
- Not transferrable to anyone not holding a Red Delegate's photo ID card.

Escorted Motorcade Guidelines

UN Complex Motorcade access will be coordinated by Host Country Law Enforcement (HCLE) & UNSSS

HCLE threat & risk assessment will guide managing of Motorcades entering the complex

Only vehicles/motorcades duly escorted by HCLE Officials will be allowed to enter the compound through 1st Ave.

Unescorted Vehicles

UNESCORTED vehicles will be checked at the **46th St. and 2nd Ave.**
Decals are required for entry into the UNHQ District.

Upon verification by UN Security, vehicles will proceed toward the drop off at the north side of 46th St approaching 1st Ave.

After drop off, unescorted vehicles are required to leave the location.

Occupants will then cross at designated checkpoint and proceed to the southside turnstile of the North Screening Building entrance.

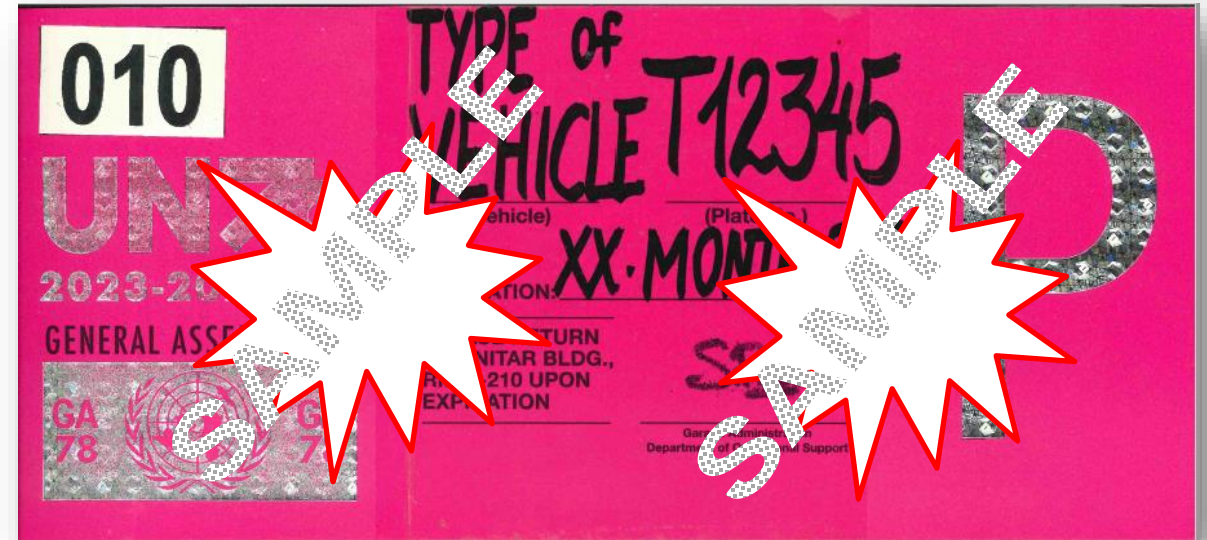
Escorted Motorcades/ Unescorted Vehicles

TEMPORARY DRIVER'S MOTORCADE PASS



- For Non-Mission temporary drivers
- Allows driver to pass through the checkpoint on 2nd Ave to drop off passengers on 1st Ave.
- Allows entry on motorcades to UNHQ
- Issued by UN Special Services Unit (SSU)

DECAL



- Vehicles that will drop off & pick up only
- **Waiting is not allowed**
- Issued by UN Garage Admin (Department of Operational Support)

Arrangements for National Security

UNHQ remains a “weapons free” zone

Numbers of national security elements admitted with delegations will be strictly controlled

National security elements must engage directly with Security and Safety Services to coordinate appropriate coverage for delegations

Security and Safety Service will coordinate closely with host country counterparts in terms of support to delegations

Areas **Allowed** for National Security Personnel

Holding area at the Delegates entrance, GA Building (left side)

Outside the GA Hall (on the 2nd floor east side entrance)

**Secretariat Building 27th and 38th floor in the outer vestibule
by reception desk**

**Conference room (in the vicinity of the entrance to the
Conference rooms)**

Outside Security Council chamber close to Turkish Lounge

Areas **Restricted** for National Security Personnel

SG and DSG's suites or offices on 38th floor of Secretariat Building & corridors leading to these areas

PGA's suite or office on 2nd floor of Conference Bldg

Inside Conference rooms when meetings are in progress

Inside GA Hall and inside GA-200 area

Inside Security Council chamber and Quiet Room
