Introduction


1. The Applicant, a former staff member of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), contests the decision by UNDP, dated 13 February 2008, not to extend her appointment of limited duration (ALD) beyond 21 March 2008 due to the closure of the Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) project, which she was working for in Darfur, Sudan.

2. The parties having agreed to terms of settlement, incorporated in a document, signed by their duly authorized representatives, and lodged with the Tribunal;

IT IS ORDERED THAT

3. All further proceedings be stayed to allow time for the full terms of the agreement to be implemented.

4. BY CONSENT, upon the terms of settlement being satisfied this application will stand dismissed on withdrawal by the Applicant.
