Excellency,

Reference is made to the letter of the Co-Facilitators of the intergovernmental process for the Declaration on Future Generations, dated 31 May 2024, with which we transmitted the REV1 of the Declaration on Future Generations, including an Explanatory Note indicating our working methodology in progressing from the zero draft to this REV1.

We take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude to all delegations for their active engagement in the reading of REV1 of the Declaration on Future Generations, held on 10 and 14 June. The collaborative spirit and constructive interventions made by delegations underscore our shared commitment towards the needs and interests of future generations.

At the request of some delegations, we also take this opportunity to share with you the explanation of the concept, "intergenerational multiplier effect", provided by the Co-Facilitators during the informal consultations held on 14 June upon reflection on the intergovernmental negotiations on paragraph 5 of the text.

As we proceed with the reading of REV1, we aim to ensure that all Member States have the opportunity to articulate their positions and reflect their priorities through their interventions, on a paragraph-by-paragraph basis. In recognition of the need for additional readings to accommodate this process, we have revised the timeline for the Declaration on Future Generations accordingly.

The reading of REV1 will therefore resume on 26 June 2024, from 10:00AM to 1:00PM in the Trusteeship Council Chamber, and we will continue a paragraph-by-paragraph approach to negotiating the text, beginning with paragraph 15 in the Guiding Principles. Member States and Observers will be limited to two (2) minutes per intervention, per paragraph. Interventions made on behalf of groups will be limited to four (4) minutes.
