- 1. The Credentials Committee ("the Committee"), established on December 7,2000, by the Diplomatic Conference on the Protection of Audiovisual Performances, met for the second time on December 14,2000.
- 2. ThedelegationsofthefollowingStates, elected members of the Committee by the DiplomaticConference, attended the meeting: Bulgaria, China, Costa Rica, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Morocco and Ukraine.
- 3. ThePresidentoftheCommittee,elected bytheDiplomaticConference,was Mr.DimiterGantchev(Bulgaria).TheVice -Presidents,electedbytheDiplomatic Conference,wereMs.ChristianeDaleiden-Distefano(Luxembourg)andMr. RajaRezaRaja ZaibShah(Malaysia).
- 4. Inaccordancewith Rule 9(1)oftheRulesofProcedureadoptedbytheConferenceon December7,2000(documentIAVP/DC/5;"theRulesofProcedure"),theCommittee examinedthecredentialsandfullpowersreceivedsinceitsfirstmeetingon December8, 2000.

- 5. The Committee found in order the following further communications:
  - (a) asfarasthe MemberDelegations are concerned,

(i)the *credentials* and *fullpowers* (thatis,credentialsforparticipating in the Conference and signing the Final Actof the Conference, and fullpowers to sign the Instrument to be adopted by the Diplomatic Conference) of the delegations of the following 14 States:

Belarus Hungary
Benin Kenya
Bulgaria Madagascar
BurkinaFaso Mali
China Morocco
Ghana Togo

Guinea UnitedStatesofAmerica

(ii) the *credentials* withoutfull powers (that is, credentials for participating in the Conference and signing the Final Actof the Conference) of the delegations of the following 11 States:

Haïti Rwanda
Israel Senegal
Jordan Ukraine
Lithuania Venezuela
Namibia VietNam

Poland

(b) asfarasthe *Observer Delegations* are concerned, the *credentials* of the delegation of the following State:

Iran(IslamicRepublicof)

(c) asfarasthe *ObserverOrganizations* are concerned, the *letters* or *documents of appointment* of representatives of the following Observer Organizations:

non-governmental organizations: American Film Market Association (AFMA), International Association of Audio-Visual Writers and Directors (AIDAA), International Literary and Artistic Association (ALAI) (3).

6. The Committee recommends to the Conference, meeting in Plenary, to accept the credentials and full powers of the delegations mentioned in paragraph 5(a)(i), above, the credentials of the delegations mentioned in paragraph 5(a)(ii) and 5(b), above, and the letters or documents of appointment of the representatives of the organizations mentioned in paragraph 5(c), above.

7. The Committee noted that, as at the end of its second meeting, the total number of full powers, credentials and letters or documents of appointment was as follows:

28fullpowers:27 *MemberDelegations* and one*SpecialDelegation*; 81credentials:79 *MemberDelegations* and two*ObserverDelegations*; 43lettersordocumentsofappointment:seven *intergovernmentalorganizations* and 36 *non-governmentalorganizations*.

- 8. TheCommitteere-expressedthewishthattheSecretariatshouldbringRules 6 ("CredentialsandFullPowers"),7("LettersofAppointment"),8("Presentationof Credentials,etc.")and 10("ProvisionalParticipation")oftheRulesofProceduretothe attentionoftheMemberDelegationsortheObserverDelegationsnothavingpresented credentialsorfullpowersandoftherepresentativesoftheObserverOrganizationsnothaving presentedlettersorotherdocumentsofappointment.
- 9. The Committee decided that are porton its second meeting should be prepared by the Secretariat and is sue das its second report, to be presented by the President of the Committee to the Conference, meeting in Plenary.
- 10. The Committee authorized its President to examine any further communications concerning the Member Delegations, the Observer Delegations, or the Observer Organizations which might be received by the Secretariat after the close of its second meeting and to report the reon to the Conference, meeting in Plenary, unless the President deemed it necessary to convene the Committee to examine and report on those communications.
