## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Membership Student Agreement/Conduct Expectations

- 1. Seventh graders will conduct themselves in a manner that displays respect for themselves and others, including those in the program, staff, guests, and other YMCA members.
  - Participants will use respectful manners, actions, and language and not use vulgar obscene, harassing, or hurtful language.
  - Participants will not engage in physical contact with others in a joking, disrespectful, or harmful way.
  - Participants are responsible for their belongings. The YMCA is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- 2. The following could result in immediate removal from the program:
  - Use of any alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products
  - Theft of any kind
  - · Destruction of property or vandalism
  - Fighting, threatening, or aggressive behavior
  - Disruption of or not following these guidelines for each area of the facility
- Participants who do not comply could be asked to leave for the remainder of the day, could be suspended
  for a period of time, or could be removed from the program. Removal from the program would include
  termination of YMCA membership.
