# **Local Food Fundraising**

Use New Brunswick food as part of your next fundraiser and get up to 50% back!

The New Brunswick Department of Agriculture, Aquaculture and Fisheries' Local Food Fundraising Rebate Program offers school groups and not-for-profits who host a fundraiser or community meal that features local NB produce or seafood with a rebate of up to 50% of the local food purchased. Rebate up to 50% of eligible costs up to a maximum of \$1,500 per year.

## Why fundraise with local food?

It maximizes your fundraising efforts and grows the awareness of local food grown and harvested in New Brunswick.

It promotes healthy eating habits for your community while supporting the local economy. It provides high-quality, local, fresh, and seasonal produce and/or seafood to your community.

It supports NB farmers and/or fishers and strengthens community connections.

## What is required?

#### For all projects:

- Quotes for costs from the NB producer/supplier.
- Project description of the activity that identifies how the project will benefit a NB community. All proceeds raised must be donated to support an identified need within the community or school.
- Provide a plan of how the NB products and producers will be promoted during the initiative or event.

#### Additional for community meals:

- Meals should feature 100% NB primary produce or seafood purchase directly from farmer, fisher or harvester in New Brunswick.
- Value-added products like seasonings and beverages are not eligible expenses.
- Food from outside of New Brunswick not eligible expenses.
- Provide a list of ingredients and identify the NB producer or suppliers.
- Applicants must contact the regional Health Protection Branch of the Department of Health to see if a license or permit is required. If required, proof must be submitted with your application.
