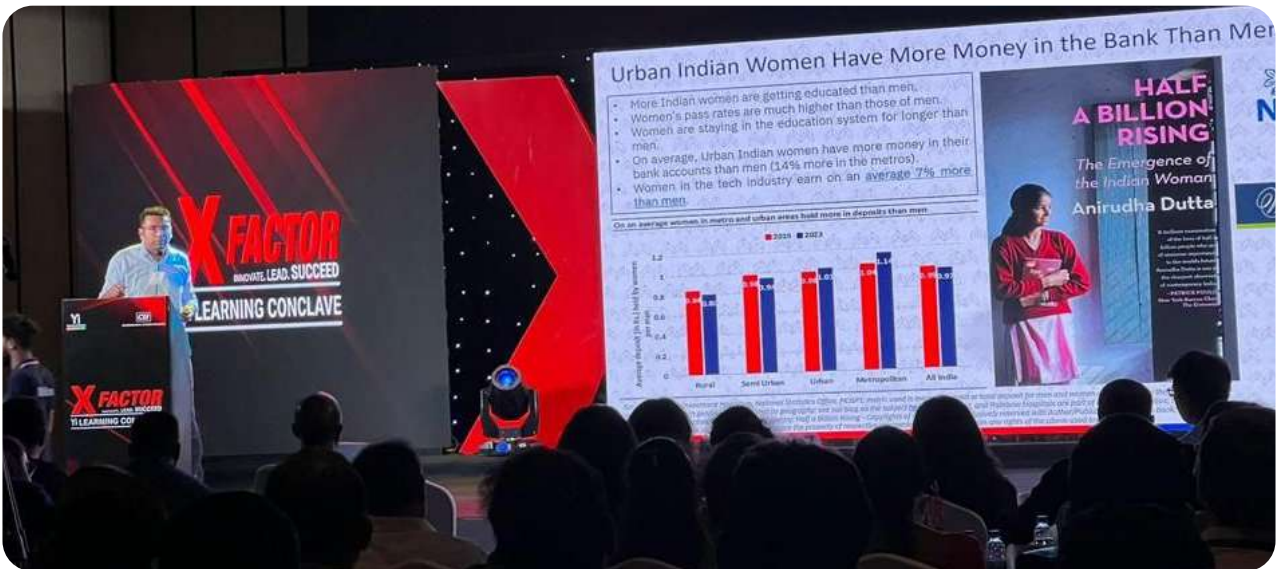

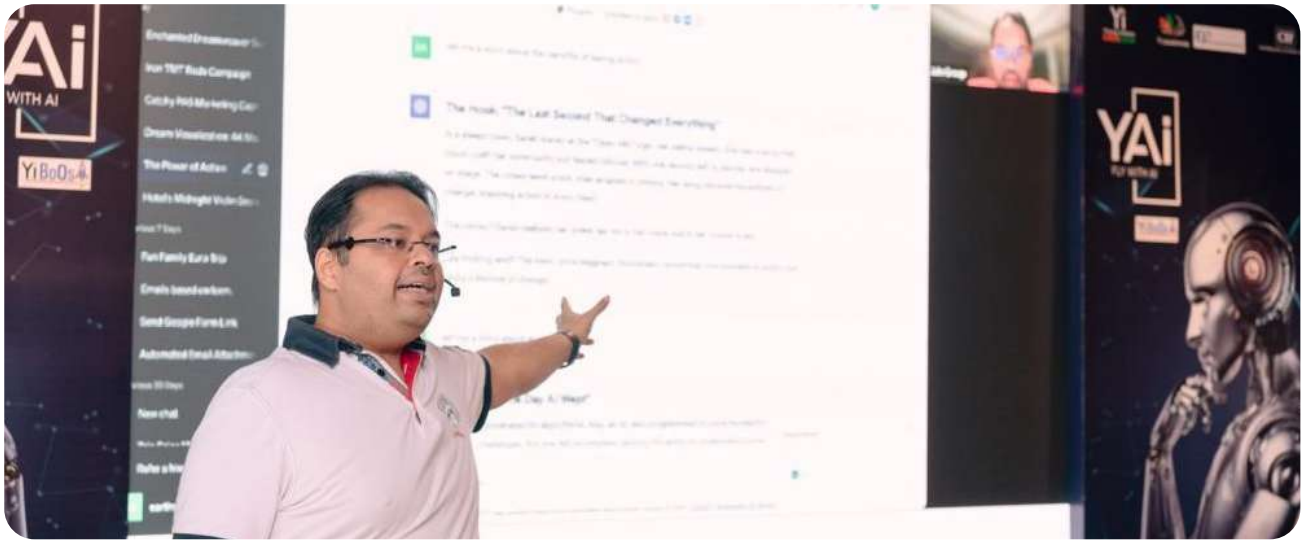

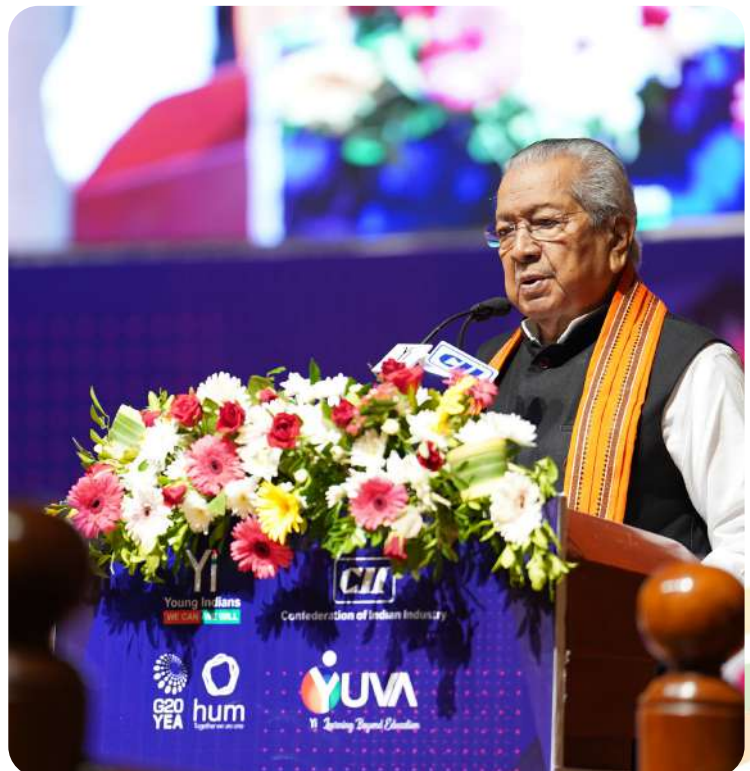
Raipur

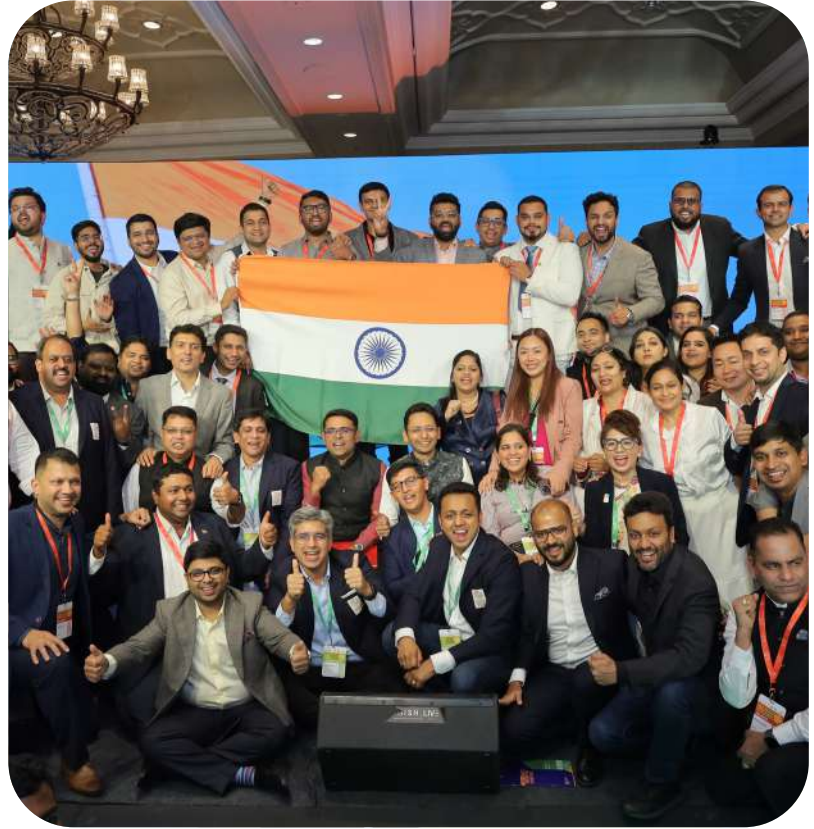

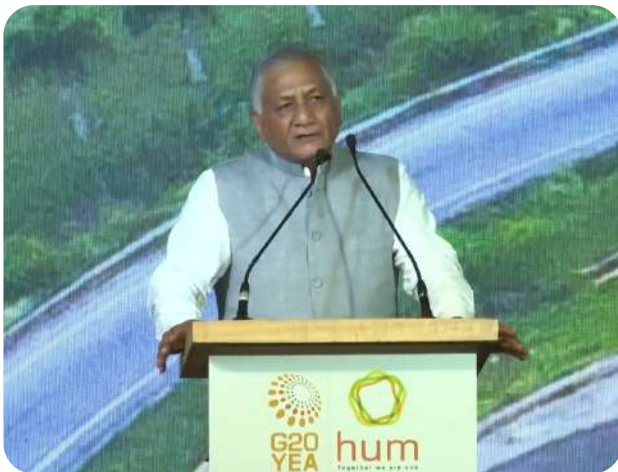

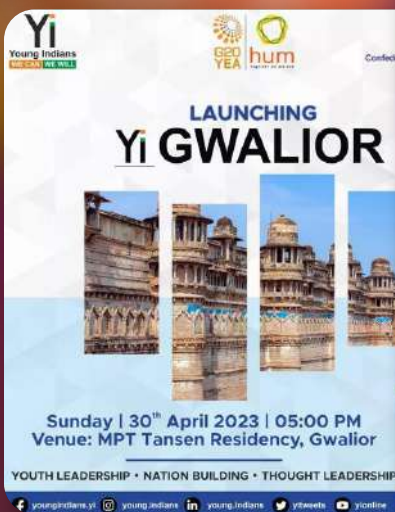

In the year 2023, Yi Masoom Initiative has organised 1200 activities across 65 chapters across the country. Through our engagement with schools and societies Yi has touched the lives of over 2 lakh stakeholders directly and 1 million audience is reached indirectly through our engagement with local radio, theatres, posters etc.

About 1.7 lakh school students, 15000 marginalised children/adults were sensitized on safe and unsafe touch in which over 8000 YUVA students and Yi members were engaged and about 500 adults were trained to be trainers on child safety and prevention of child sexual abuse.

Yi Chapters also organized campaigns in various cities through rallies, hoardings, theatre festivals, kid-only carnivals, exhibitions, skits, the celebration of Yi Masoom Day and Week, and talk shows on radio and TV channels in order to garner support for our cause and raise public awareness about child protection.

Yi National Masoom Summit 2023

Yi has organized the Third Fourth Edition of Yi National Masoom Summit on the theme Together for Safer Future on 28th October 2023 at New Delhi.

The summit was inaugurated by of Mr Sanjeev Kumar Chadha, Additional Secretary, Women and Child Development Ministry, Government of India. Speaking on the occasion he said that we have around 40% population is children and young population. And it's a strength the nation has and it's our responsibility to work together with the organizations like Yi and other organizations to ensure that all children are aware and remain safe. Our prime minister has given us a motto that “No child should be left behind”.



To address the Digital Safety in children, Yi Masoom has released the Digilante Module comprising of Introduction to Digital Safety module and Digilante animation video for 11+ age. With this module, Yi aims to reach out to every child even engaging YUVA students. Digilante animation is a self learning, refresher video that will take our ability to impact beyond conducting in person sessions.

Addressing the summit, Mr Dilip Krishna, National Chairman, Yi said that Masoom is one of the key projects of Yi, where we work on various initiatives towards creating awareness on child safety and protection and eliminating child sexual abuse and harassment with awareness sessions, campaigns, events and social media across the country.



Earlier welcoming the participants, Ms Sangeeta M, National Chair-Masoom said that the project has come a long way, affecting millions of people in communities and receiving support from well-known figures. Yi conducts awareness and sensitization sessions with children, teachers and parents/caregivers. Yi also collaborates with authorities and administration for support towards our cause and to spread awareness about child protection to the public by organising campaigns in cities through rallies, hoardings, theatre festivals, carnivals for kids, exhibitions, skits and talk shows on radio and TV channels.

The today's theme of summit "Together for a Safer Future" emphasizes the significance of open dialogue and awareness said by Mr Prateek Shukla, National Co Chair-Masoom-Yi while proposing the vote thanks during the Inaugural session of the summit.

During the summit various subject experts have shared their views and future course necessary to fight child sexual abuse.

Yi Masoom Week 2023

Yi Masoom continuing its efforts to keep children safe by creating awareness on child safety amongst young children, parents and other stakeholders has organised the Yi Masoom Week 30 October -4 November 2023.

During the week, Yi Chapter organised the various activities like Conducted Masoom awareness sessions, sessions on Digilante Module, train for trainer programs for teachers with the various CSE through flash mob skit also screening the Komal video in the theatres and braille Masoom Pamphlets for specially important children's



Road Safety



Road Accidents are of the leading causes of death, disability and hospitalization of people worldwide in general and Indian particular. One out of 10 people killed on roads across the world is from India, according to the World Health Organization.

The Annual Report on 'Road Accidents in India-2022' has been published by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways. As per the report, a total of 4,61,312 road accidents have been reported by States and Union Territories (UTs) during the calendar year 2022, which claimed 1,68,491 lives and caused

injuries to 4,43,366 persons. This marks an increase of 11.9% in accidents, 9.4% in fatalities, and 15.3% in injuries compared to the previous year. These figures are worrisome and importance of Road Safety on the roads in a country like India cannot be overlooked by any organization or individual today.

Under the Yi pillar of National Building, Road Safety has been one of the main projects of Yi for last few years. The vertical of Road Safety is passionate about creating awareness among young children, so that road discipline and safety is part of their ethos from a young age. For the youth of the country it is to ensure that Road Safety rules and regulations are followed, and an emphasis is created for everybody else in the society to do so by doing campaigns, programs and being part of the ecosystem of the administrations across the country.

The objective is to educate people on the importance of abiding traffic rules and imbibing in them a responsibility to take care of the fellow Indians which is done through below modules -

Farishtey: Yi Farishtey focuses on providing awareness session on the Good Samaritan Act. The purpose of a Good Samaritan law is to provide legal protection to bystanders who come to the aid and rescue of victims of road crashes. We have reached to 1,50,000 Students this year

Farishtey Trainers (First Responders) - Certified Farishtey Program is designed to train the people in Emergency Response at the accident site and how to handle the situation by providing first aid. As per the reports, nearly 50 per cent of road fatalities would not have happened if medical attention been given within the first hour. Yi is partnering with EMRI Green Health Services to enable trained Farishtey's to administer immediate post-crash first aid and assistance in case of road accidents in the communities they live.

Chota COP Project: The project aims to increase awareness on the need of Road Safety among the Children. The project purpose is to create agents/chota cops who remind parents and others in society about Road Safety. We have reached to 3,50,000 Students this year.

Animal Protection Program: Rural Road Safety Animal Protection program to protect animals and to avoid accidents with animals on the roads.

Yi National Road Safety Summit 2023:

Yi had organised First Edition of National Road Safety Summit 2023 on 6 October 2023 at New Delhi to celebrate its Road Safety initiatives and bring out a document, collating the voice of our Youth.

General (Dr) V.K. Singh, PVSM, AVSM, YSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Minister of State for Road Transport & Highways & Civil Aviation was the Chief Guest during the summit. Mr Dilip Krishna, National Chairman, Yi presented Yi Road Safety Communique to Hon'ble minister.

Yi has developed four road safety videos in English, Hindi, and Tamil to raise awareness of the Good Samaritan Law and emergency first responders in partnership with Schwing Stetter India which was launched during the summit.

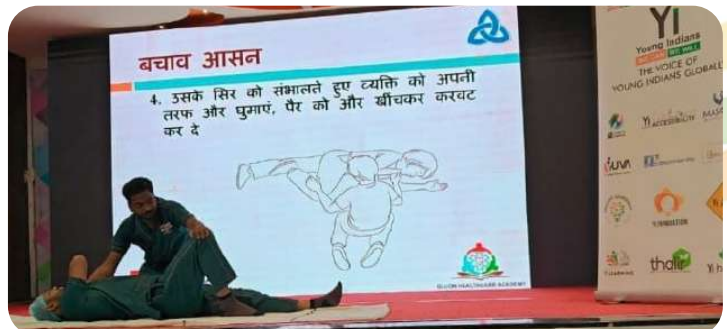


Yi Health

The expo provided an opportunity for 100+ millet product producers and entrepreneurs from different parts of Tamil Nadu to exhibit and sell their products."

Kidpreneur event conducted by Thalir & Entrepreneurship verticals was held for the future generation of our country. The basic motto behind this was to make kids aware of various aspects of business as they are the future business persons of our country.

A Masterclass on Power & Persuasion by a Harvard Professor, Professor John Paul Rollert was organised by Yi Bengaluru all Yi Chapters to members across India. Over 125 members understood on Power & Persuasion-by-an-expert speaker and helped them to be aware on the subject and implement in their entrepreneurial journey.

YiBe (Young Indians Business Exchange) platform was launched as a part of Entrepreneurship Summit 2023. "E 2.0: Venture Forward". Yi Bengaluru organized and executed a Structured Networking Event that brought together our members and participants from the Indo-German Young Leaders Forum (IGYLF). This session facilitated valuable connections and enabled our members to expand their networks while forging deeper relationships with young leaders from Germany.

Yi National Entrepreneurship Month was observed from 15 September – 15 October 2023 where chapters have organised various events including Video interview of a local Entrepreneur, Design thinking / AI / Chat GPT related workshop, Sahaas session with entrepreneurs who started ventures that did not succeed but had value lessons and Cycle rally or Mini marathon concluding with E-ship pledge.



INNOVATION



In India's quest for sustainable development and economic growth, instilling a culture of innovation is indispensable. This focus on innovation is essential to tackle the country's varied challenges, especially in pivotal sectors like healthcare, education, and agriculture. Innovation here is more than a tool; it's a mindset that can drastically improve the lives of India's vast populace and sustain its economic momentum.

For Young Indians, an organization deeply intertwined with nation-building efforts and engaging a diverse group including college and school students, entrepreneurs, professionals, and rural communities, fostering a culture of innovation is critical.

By integrating innovative thinking into their programs, Young Indians can nurture a new generation of creative problem-solvers and visionary leaders. This culture of innovation is particularly crucial in education, where it can empower young minds to think critically and inventively. In the realm of entrepreneurship, it encourages sustainable and socially responsible business models. Similarly, in rural communities, innovative approaches can bring transformative solutions to longstanding challenges. For Young Indians, promoting a culture of innovation is not just about achieving their goals; it's about setting a precedent for the nation, inspiring transformative change across India, and positioning the country as a global leader in innovative thought and practice. This year, we conducted a few activities at the national level as well as rolled out structured activities for the chapters to organize.

Yi IDS 3 Competition 2023

Our flagship initiative, IDS (Imagine | Do | Share), launched its 3rd edition and saw a 150% increase in registrations from our stakeholders - Yuva, Thalir, and Members. The theme this year was Health and Wellness, with the competition tagline "Innovate for a Healthy India". Throughout the 3-month schedule of the competition, teams came up with ideas and prototypes based on the theme. The finals saw 14 teams battle it out with their innovations for the prize money, which ultimately resulted in 4 winners as follows - 1st place: Team E-Vaidya (Nashik), 2nd place: Team Meditech (Chh. Sambhaji Nagar), 3rd place: Team Noblecure (Madurai), and Team Medswill (Siliguri).

Yi Thalir Innovation Festival

Thalir Innovation Fest 2023, a National Level Inter-School Competition, was the first of its kind event planned in collaboration between the Thalir stakeholder and Yi Innovation. The aim of the event was to test and inspire every student's creativity, emotional intelligence, and ability in critical thinking and problem-solving. This fest engaged students with varied interests, from arts & fine arts to science.

The festival took place at Kumaraguru Institutions, Coimbatore and attracted students from across India. The event was a resounding success, with 500 student participants from 7 cities and 17 schools, attracting 1500+ attendees who enthusiastically explored the Science Tech Expo and industrial displays.

The fest featured more than 60 science exhibits, 11 industrial displays, and an experiential planetarium. Participants tackled real-world problem statements, designing innovative prototypes with potential societal benefits.

Yuva Bharathi Public School from Coimbatore emerged as the winners of the National Thair Innovation Fest, with Johnson Grammar School from Hyderabad and GD Matriculation Higher Secondary School from Coimbatore securing second and third places, respectively. These top three champions will have the unique opportunity to collaborate with the Indian STEP & Business Incubator Association (ISBA) - a pan-India network of Business Incubators, providing mentorship to help students develop and transform their ideas into real-world applications.

Yi-Cultinno Collaboration

Yi Innovation has entered a collaboration with an organization of significance called Cultinno, which will allow our stakeholders to participate in challenging innovation pursuits presented by leading Indian companies, promising appealing incentives. Through this collaboration, Yi stakeholders will get access to Cultinno's wide network of resources to help bolster their innovative journey and also get connected with leading innovators and mentors.

Design Thinking Initiative

Yi has taken a proactive approach to foster innovation and problem-solving skills among its stakeholders through Design Thinking workshops. The Design Thinking workshops were a strategic endeavor, encompassing both Train the Trainer and Stakeholder participation sessions. The Yuva Stakeholder completed 42 Design Thinking workshops across all chapters under the FUTURE 3.0 initiative.

These workshops had a human-centered approach to problem-solving that encourages empathy, ideation, and prototyping. Train the Trainer sessions ensured a cascading effect, where the knowledge and expertise gained by a select group could be disseminated widely across multiple stakeholders.

Climate Change, the hot topic and of course the need of the hour – we can feel it year on year with the extremes and fluctuations in climatic conditions, not to mention the natural disasters that are an unfortunate byproduct of climate change. It is quite heartwarming to see Yi doing its best in trying to educate and empower people to understand climate change and take proactive measures in reducing its ill effects. Yi's Climate Change initiative aims to bring together the nation's youth and engage them for positive climate action.

Some of our areas of engagement include:

- Empowering children to understand and tackle climate change
- Encourage young people to come to the forefront of climate change conversations
- Enable young people to develop skills to adapt to climate change effectively
- Support rural population for skill development and sustainable climate change solutions
- Initiate projects for climate adaptation and mitigation, focusing on disaster management, relief

Yi's Climate Change initiative also engages at the local, state, national and international levels with governments and organizations for climate change advocacy.

Over the years Yi has responded towards and supported disaster relief work, initiated afforestation and water conservation projects across the country and also participated at the UN Climate Change Conference 26 (UNFCCC COP 26) in Glasgow. Taking it a step further, in March 2023 we had the privilege of sharing our work on Climate change and health verticals on ground, at the WHO South East Asia Region summit in Delhi, with representatives from nine different countries.

• Under Rural Initiatives Yi started a new activity of Pond Rejuvenation. Water Conservation Knowledge Session with Ramveer Tanvar - PondMan of India was held on the World Water Day, 22nd March 2023 to learn about Pond rejuvenation which is an important mission in rural India. Ponds serve as a critical source of water for irrigation, drinking, and other daily activities. In many rural areas, ponds have become silted and polluted due to neglect and misuse, which has led to a decrease in their water-holding capacity and quality.

Few Yi Chapters took this Challenge and more than 20 Ponds have been Rejuvenated which hold more than 50 million liters of water, directly impacting lives and livelihoods of the nearby population and helping preserve biodiversity.



Tree Plantation Drives

Tree plantation isn't just about planting trees; it's also about nurturing and caring for them as they grow. Each tree planted contributes to a larger ecosystem, making a lasting impact on the environment and society.

Trees are conserved, maintained, or new trees are planted, and they continue to absorb CO₂, functioning as an ongoing carbon sink. Nationally, Yi has planted more than 3 million trees mainly adapting the Miyawaki afforestation method thus contributing significantly to bolster the planet's capacity to sequester carbon. In a first, Yi partnered with Schwing Stetter to take forward the plantation drive and plant trees across the country through Miyawaki & normal plantation. The collaboration which required clear communication, shared goals, and a commitment from each one involved, fostered a sense of achievement and a desire to make a more significant and lasting impact on the environment through tree plantation initiatives.

An MOU has been signed with Climate Reality Organization for content development for Thalir & YUVA. The purpose of this partnership is to generate awareness about environmental issues like clean energy, waste management, conservation of water, tree plantation and education on climate change science, solutions, and impacts.



The speakers for the event included Yi National Management Team members and key eminent climate leaders from CII IGBC, Climate Project foundation, Design Village, OMI Foundation, Budding Botanicals, Global Shaper Community, AIC Sangam. Yi Chapters across India also conducted various Climate Change activities between 01 - 07 October 2023.



The key focus areas for the Yi Climate Action Week 2023 were:

- Each One Plant One- Planting trees to combat deforestation to facilitate carbon sequestration. An engaging activity for members and their families.
- Clean-Up Events: Organized community clean-up activities to promote environmental stewardship. Arranged climate walks and bicycle rides to raise awareness, while encouraging stakeholders to take on challenges like reducing plastic waste, conserving water, or adopting a vegetarian diet for a week.
- Educational Workshops: Hosted workshops and webinars to educate Thalir about climate change, its impacts, and solutions. Featured artworks that addressed climate change issues.
- Carbon Footprint Challenges: Encouraged people to calculate and reduce their carbon footprints, while teaching them how to make their homes more energy efficient.
- Public Talks: Invited experts to deliver talks on climate science, policy, and action at schools and colleges and involved students in activities like environmental clubs and art competitions.
- Local Policy Advocacy: Engaged with local policymakers to discuss climate-friendly policies and Community Resilience Planning
- Rural Initiative: Initiated educational programs to promote sustainable land management practices that reduce soil erosion, improve water retention, and enhance soil fertility.
- Campaigns across different colleges also promoted long term capacity building of the institutions by training teachers/educators in implementing Green Campus Program to subsequently help them in spreading awareness and creating positive change about the issue.

Over 300 campaigns and activities were held throughout the year to create awareness on Climate Change actions and mitigation which directly impacted the lives of around 1 million people. Awareness was created on carbon neutrality and green meetings were promoted across Yi. In addition, members were encouraged to reduce carbon footprints in their daily lives and become accountable, through practices like water conservation, compost awareness, and e-waste management.

Accessibility



The overarching goal for Accessibility vertical this year was to engage every chapter in delivering a common minimum program for all our stakeholders. Following the directives from our national leadership we drafted a common minimum program tailored to each stakeholder ensuring it can be effectively implemented by every chapter whether small or big to deliver on those common minimum programme. The past year has been very challenging in terms of engaging all the 65 chapters in executing the project.

Although the targets which were set during the initial months of this year were quite modest and could not be fully achieved, we still take pride in the significant work that was accomplished by the chapters. The vertical was able to create a substantial impact on all four stakeholders

Membership

Chapters collaborated with restaurants to introduce Braille-friendly menus for the visually impaired, launching a total of 100 braille menus across chapters.

Going the extra mile, Yi Raipur transformed the Raipur railway station into a Braille friendly facility, incorporating 126 touch points specifically designed to assist individuals with visual impairments.

Yi Indore Spearheaded efforts to establish the first 5 digit helpline number 14456 for the deaf community in collaboration with Ministry of Social Justice and welfare

Yi Guwahati awarded the "Best Accessible Restaurant" for exemplary practices, ensuring specially-abled people in Guwahati have better access to infrastructure in cafes and restaurants.

Many Chapters engaged in a game of cricket with individuals who have physical disabilities to gain insight into their experiences and promote inclusivity within society. Notably, thanks to Yi Raipur's advocacy with the state government, the Chhattisgarh Wheelchair Cricket Association and its players received 15 sports wheelchairs.

Yi Noida Conducted an accessibility audit of a co-working space for doctors, while Yi Goa collaborated with local government authorities to raise awareness about making neighbourhood's accessible.

Yi Kolkata's unique dine in the dark experience garnered significant attention and became a popular topic not just within Kolkata but also in other chapters. Kolkata lent its support to assist

Kolkata's "Uthe Sab ki Kadam" accessibility initiative, which involved the donation of prosthetic limbs, resonated with many chapters. A total of 1750 limbs were donated across various chapters, with Kolkata taking the lead by contributing 1400 limbs this year alone. This brought their total contribution to more than 4500+ limbs. All the funds for this initiative were generated through the collective efforts of chapter members or through corporate CSR funds.

The majority of chapters celebrated significant occasions and festivals with individuals with special abilities, thereby exemplifying inclusivity in society. During their key members' event, chapters showcased the talents of specially-abled children through dance and singing performances.

Yi Jamshedpur welcomed a visually impaired individual into their chapter to enhance their capacity to undertake more meaningful and impactful projects.

Yuva

Within the Yuva initiative, chapters initiated contact with accomplished individuals with disabilities, who shared their life journeys and motivation with college students.

Yi Erode, Yi Raipur, and Yi Puduchery explored topics related to social entrepreneurship.

Several chapters organized the "Ramp It Up" drive through Yuva students, collaborating with college administrations to enhance the accessibility of their campuses.

Yi Kolkata provided a unique "Dine in the Dark" experience for Yuva students.

Thalir

Under the Thalir initiative, chapters established MOUs with 35 schools for individuals with disabilities. They executed significant Yi projects, including Project Masoom, entrepreneurship programs and financial literacy initiatives.

Various chapters organized drawing competitions for autistic students, as well as painting workshops, dance workshops, mental health awareness events, and candle making workshops.

Additionally, chapters held singing and elocution competitions for specially-abled children. Yi Surat provided a platform for these talented individuals by featuring them on Surat's local radio station.

Yi Raipur organized a sign language rendition of our national anthem, and Yi Bhopal conducted a Paralympic event with over 500 specially-abled children participating in sports such as cricket, shot put and chess.

Yi Indore successfully persuaded a reputable school to incorporate Indian Sign Language into their regular curriculum and Yi Jamshedpur organized a cricket match between Thalir kids and Jharkhand's women's blind cricket team.

Rural Initiative

In the context of our Rural Initiative, chapters took the initiative to organize eye camps and health check-up camps aimed at individuals with disabilities.

Across various chapters, awareness programs were conducted to inform people about the benefits and government schemes related to Unique Disability Identification (UDID) cards.

Yi Kanchipuram went a step further by conducting audiogram testing to assess the hearing abilities of students facing speech and hearing impairments.

Yi Indore and Yi Raipur played a crucial role by hosting job fairs, which resulted in more than 200 candidates gaining access to job opportunities.

Additionally, the kind-hearted efforts of Yi Hyderabad, Yi Delhi, Yi Jaipur, and Yi Delhi resulted in the donation of wheelchairs, providing much-needed mobility support to those in need.

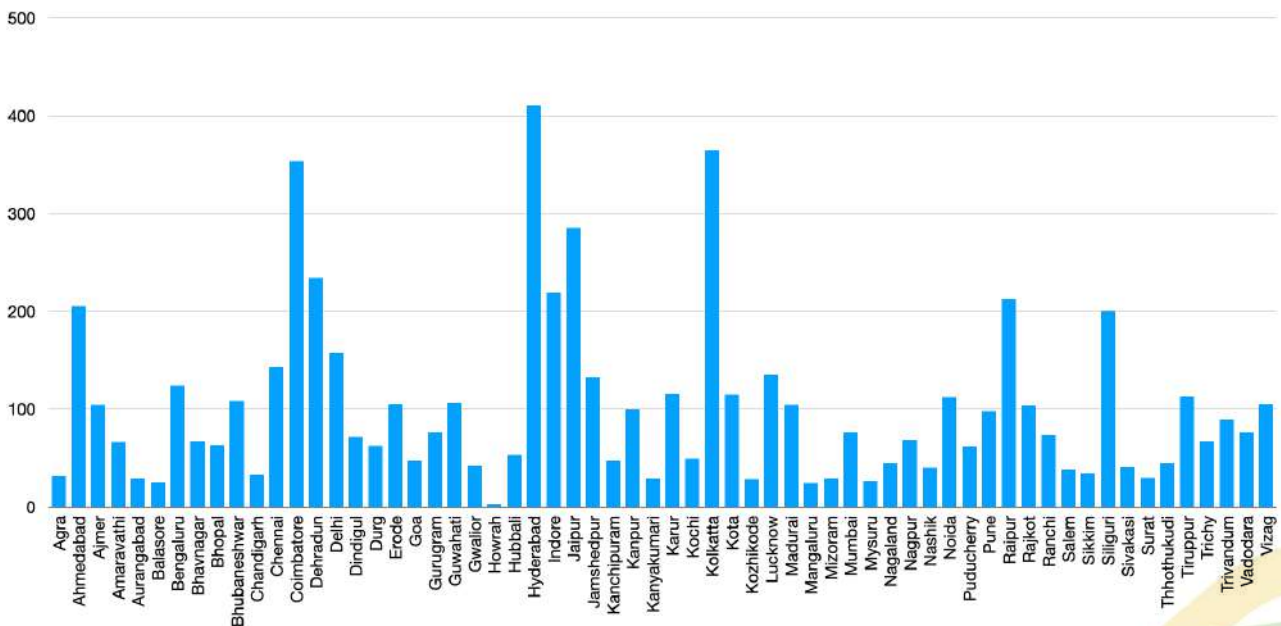


Membership

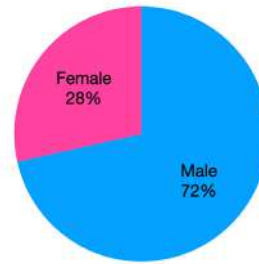
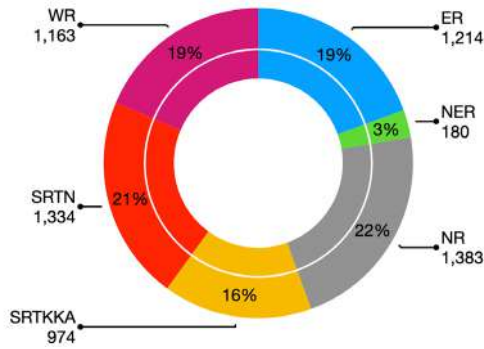


In 2023, we achieved a remarkable 24.18% increase, reaching a total of 6,223 members by the year's end, marking the highest growth rate in the past decade. This growth was propelled by the launch of 7 new chapters in cities including Nagpur, Ajmer, Durg, Gwalior, Kozhikode, Agra, and Kanyakumari, taking the total chapters to 65, up from 58, a 12% growth, with eight more chapters in the pipeline.

This expansion was vital in strengthening our presence across regions, and four regions have already surpassed the 1,000-members mark. 360° Surveys gathering member feedback on NMT & GC have played a crucial role in shaping our strategies, ensuring an improved experience for new members. Additionally, securing an exclusive flight discount partnership with Emirates and efficiently delivering membership kits to new members were significant accomplishments in 2023 that we can all be proud of.

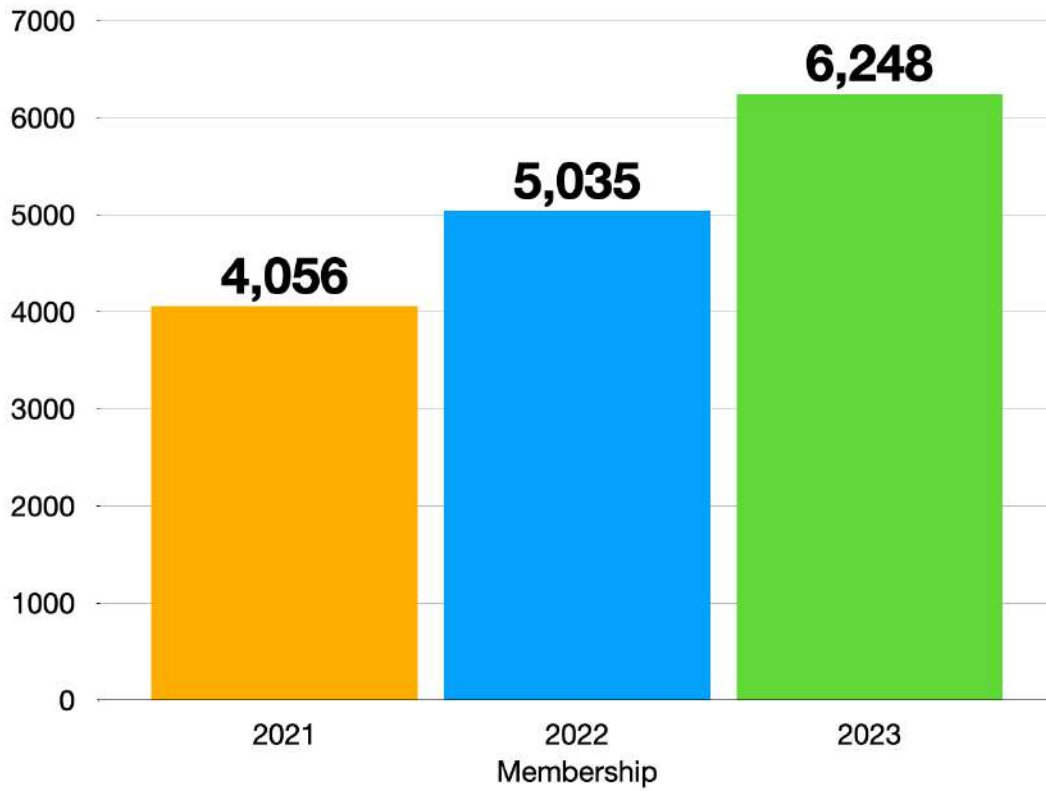


Yi Membership Demographics

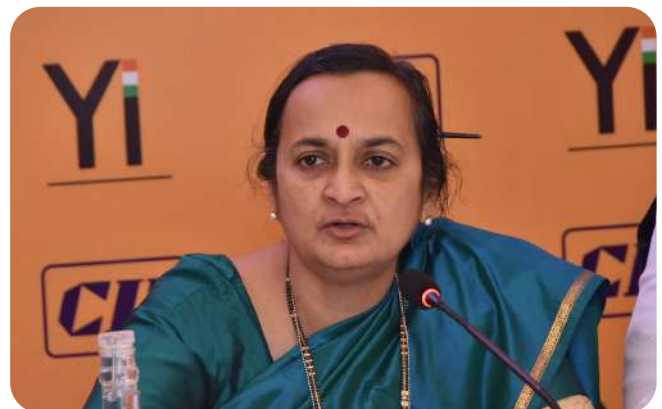

Year Highlights:

- YUVA reach: 281 Institutes and 1,82,000 students
- Yuva Handbook was released in the first NMT meeting as the holy book for Yuva, which would provide utmost clarity on the role of Yuva as well as role of each stakeholder of Yuva from chapter, college and student. It also had defined the CMP as provided by the vertical/initiative national heads.
- YUVA EC formation in each college was one of the key focus areas for the year. The presence of the YUVA EC would facilitate direct conversations between YUVA EC members and chapter vertical/initiative leaders for faster action and help with execution of CMP. This would also promote Leadership Development within YUVA students and provide them an opportunity for Personal Growth while sensitizing on subjects of Nation Building.
- YUVA Portal a digital platform for delivering content to the YUVA with anytime access to subjects of nation building at their fingertips. Value creation by issuance of completion certificates for students to showcase on social platforms and interviews. Individual accounts for each student will help them track their performance and activities.

- This year Yi has partnered with Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Yuva team organized 50 Y20 brainstorming sessions across 49 chapters on themes of Participatory Government, Industry 4.0 and Reimagining Buisness for Future India with support of chapter leadership. Yi received a financial assistance of 35 Lakhs for the same from government.
- Further we collaborated with Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and conducted 6 Design Thinking workshops on Mera Yuva Bharat as a prelude to launch of Mera Yuva Bharat by Prime Minister on 31 October 2023. The design thinking workshop concluded in Delhi with a round table of Industry experts, Academic Leaders and experts from various social groups where Mrs. Meeta Rajivlochan, Secretary (Youth Affairs), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports was the keynote speaker.
- Future 3.0 project saw participation from 22 chapters, where they conducted a design thinking workshop on problem statements under the focus areas of Future of Agritech, Manufacturing, Education, Lifestyle for Sustainability and Digital Economy. An outcome document was created to share the solutions thought by youth of each city with local and state administration.
- The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports hosted the Y20 Summit in Varanasi on 17-18 August 2023. Dr Anuj Garg, Mr Rahul Singhi & Mr Tilak Raj participated in the Y20 summit from Yi.





Thalir



Yi Thalir

Yi Thalir is an initiative that focuses on the holistic development of school children. Its mission is to collaborate with schools, empowering and nurturing every child to be independent, safe, happy, inclusive, and responsible citizens. The goal is to nurture school children, making them not only happy but also instilling a sense of responsibility for society's overall happiness.

In the year 2023, Yi has partnered with over 220 schools and on-boarded more than 2.2 lakh students across its 65 chapters, bringing the total to over 15.0 lakh students nationwide. Yi Thalir engages students through various projects and activities, including Masoom, Road Safety, Climate Change, Accessibility, Health, Entrepreneurship, and Innovation.

In this way, children can connect with and understand the importance of being safe and keeping others safe, the significance of preserving the environment, and the responsibility of becoming patriotic and compassionate citizens. The ultimate aim is to contribute to making the world a better place to live in.

Key Initiatives/Highlights of the Year

a) The chapters have partnered with over 220 schools, comprising over 2.2 lakh students across the nation, who will now embark on the transformational and impactful journey.

b) The focus under Thalir was to create a positive impact among the students with Yi's projects and initiatives and make them socially responsible. Almost 4000 kids sensitised on Child Sexual Abuse in numerous sessions (Masoom)

And, special mention to the Rural Sanitary Pad making factory, which not just helped with the know-how of setting the factory, but today is a profitable business model for the rural women.

Yi Rural Initiative structured and focused approach to delivery of Yi Projects and Initiatives in these rural communities paid rich dividends. We delivered over 262 different activities within these 93 communities, averaging almost 3 activities per community per year.
